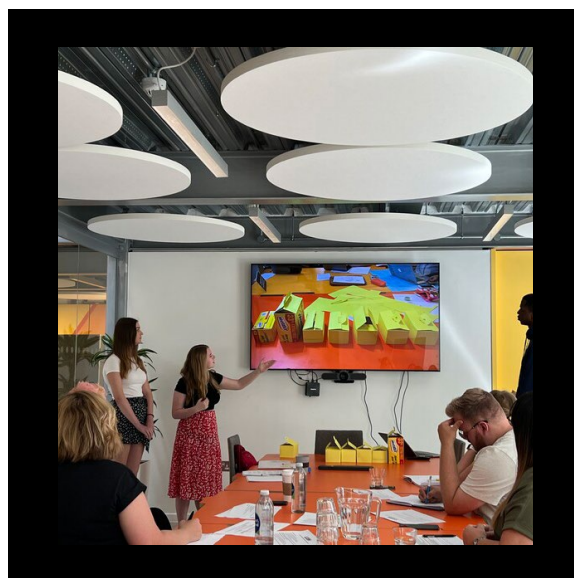

# FOUNDATION DIPLOMAS

Our one-year or six-month Foundation Diplomas give you the chance to explore different creative areas before choosing the subject you want to take a degree in.

- Foundation Diploma in Art, Design and Media (One-year)
- International Foundation Diploma (IFD) (Six-month)

There are a few key differences between our Foundation Diploma courses, but they both offer the same level of qualification and they both explore the areas of Art, Design and Media. When completed at AUB, you'll be offered a guaranteed place on one of AUB's undergraduate degrees.

The Foundation in Art, Design and Media is full-time and 1 year in length starting in September 2024 and finishes in June 2025.

The International Foundation Diploma is full-time and six months in length, starting in January 2024 and finishes in June 2024. Meaning, you could start an undergraduate degree in the same year! There's an online induction to this course in December to integrate students into the course before they arrive on campus in the new year.

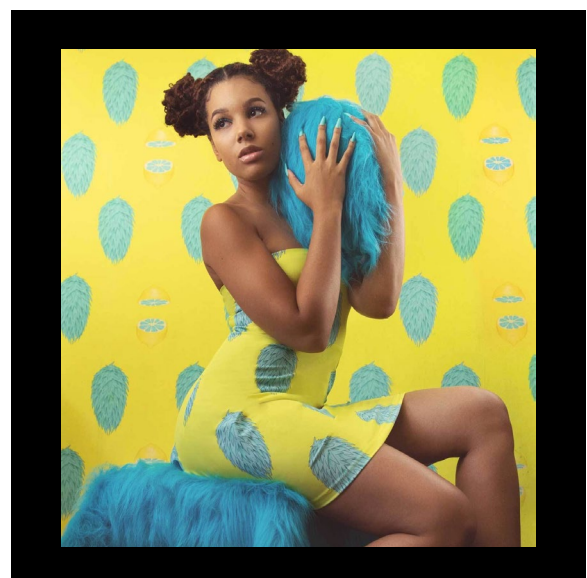

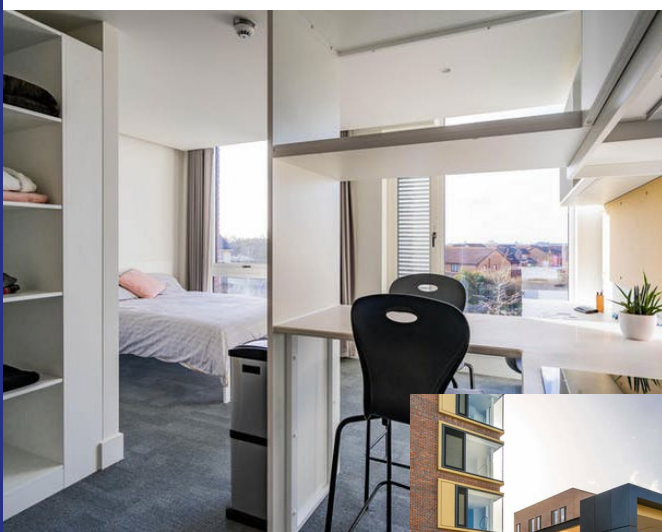

# HOW TO APPLY

## Foundation and Postgraduate courses

If you are looking to study Foundation diplomas or Postgraduate degrees, you can apply directly online.

## Undergraduate degrees

There are several routes that you can use to apply to one of our undergraduate courses depending on your circumstances.

### UCAS

- Once an application is submitted via UCAS. There is no need to submit multiple applications. For more information on UCAS and how it works, visit: [ucas.com](https://ucas.com)
- You can apply for a maximum of 5 courses in the UK.
- The UCAS application will require personal details, education history, a personal statement and references.

### Direct Application

- If you're applying for a full-time undergraduate course, you can apply to us directly, via our website, free of charge.
- If you're only applying to AUB, we'd recommend that you apply directly to us.
- Please note we can only consider direct online applications if you haven't applied and won't apply through UCAS for this year of entry. If you're applying to more than one university in the UK, you should apply through UCAS.

### Via an Agent

We have agent partners across the world who work with us to support applicants. If you'd prefer to speak to someone face-to-face about your university options and the application process, applying through an agent might be the right route for you.

# PRESESSIONAL ENGLISH

**We offer a range of English Language support for international students, both in preparation for and during their time at AUB.**

If you're applying to study with us but don't think you will meet your chosen course's minimum English Language requirements, you might qualify for one of our Preessional English courses.

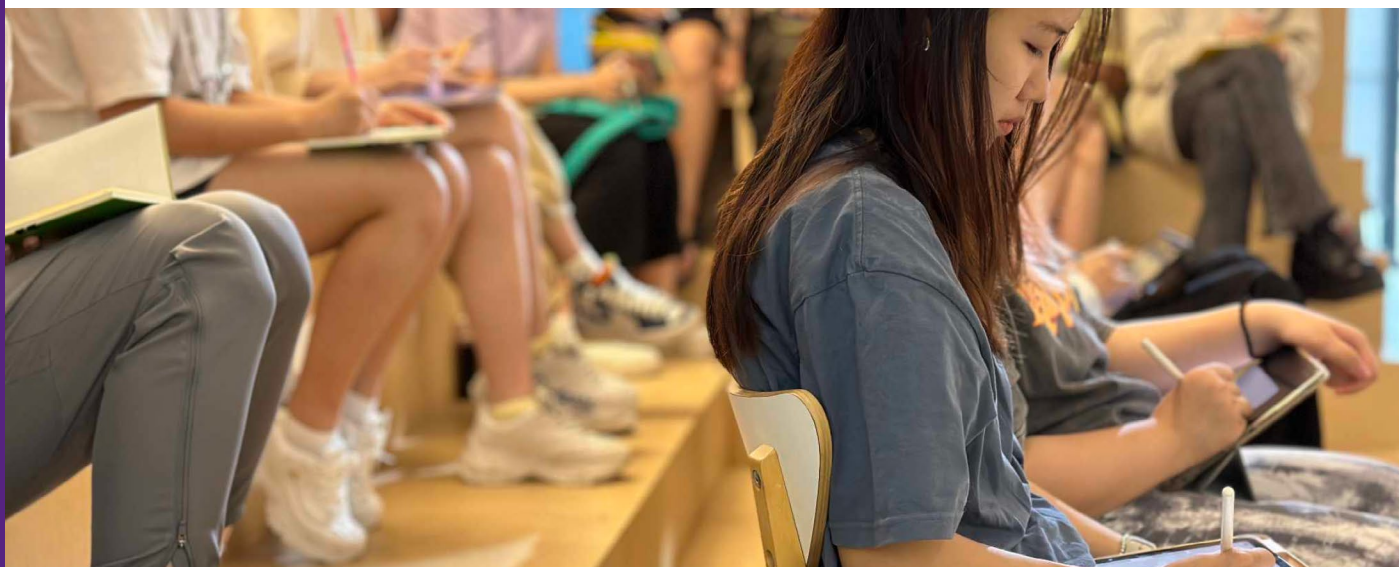
Our Preessional English and Academic Skills courses are for students who need to meet our minimum English Language requirements for their BA or MA courses. The Preessional courses will improve your ability and confidence in using English language and academic skills in your studies.

Currently, we are only able to offer Preessional courses for students applying to study at both BA and MA level. For both study levels, we provide an 11-week and a 5-week option. The course that you need to study will depend on how much you need to improve your English language skills before beginning your main course of study.

The course is fully online and includes live video-based, interactive sessions with our English for Academic Purposes lecturers and your classmates.

# VISAS

**To study a degree programme in the UK, you will need to apply for a Student Route visa and will require a passport to travel.**

- You can start your visa application 6 months before your course starts but no earlier
- You will need to ensure you have all of the necessary documents ready before making your visa application; this includes a CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies) which must be requested from AUB

# SUPPORT

## **Supporting Everyone's Needs**

Being a student involves so much more than studying. Starting university can be challenging as well as exciting. It's natural to take a while to find your feet and you may experience a hiccup along the way. We offer extra help to anyone who needs it and provide a range of specialist services to make managing your time here easier.

## **Student Advice**

Our Student Services Advisers provide advice and guidance on a range of issues including funding and financial support available for students, as well as accommodation queries and living in the community e.g. local travel and transport, local amenities and general information.

## **Study Skills and English for Academic Purposes (EAP)**

1:1 and small group study skills tutorials are available for all students for help with academic assignments, time management and academic skills. If English is not your first language, our EAP team can help you improve your language skills to get the most out of your studies.

## **Disability Support**

You don't have to tell us about your disability, but it can be useful if you do. You'll have access to more support and help for your studies, as well as possible extra funding. The Senior Disability Officer can provide advice and guidance on all disability related issues from advice on your application, to support at interview and throughout your course. We'll work in partnership with you, your course team and any external agencies to make sure that your needs are supported.

## **Wellbeing Support**

Any of our students can contact the Senior Wellbeing Officers to discuss any concerns or worries, particularly if you have mental health difficulties, addiction or eating disorders, or feel that you are struggling to remain on your course due to personal issues. This support focuses on identifying practical strategies for self management, as well as guidance on community support and services. A daily drop-in service is available for same-day support.

## **Counselling**

The Counselling Service offers single therapeutic sessions for one hour, booked on a session-by-session basis. The Counselling Service is student focused, adhering to the key theoretical principles of a person-centred approach as its foundation. Talking to a counsellor in a safe, non-judgmental and confidential setting can enable you to work through your problems with the aim of reaching a solution. Our Counselling Service maintains a professional accreditation awarded by the BACP (British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy) and there is a choice of male and female counsellors available.

# GRADUATE ROUTE

The Graduate Route for international students who have successfully completed their studies in the UK is available to graduates at undergraduate level or above. The visa route allows graduates to live and work in the UK for two years (three years for PhD Graduates) after completing their studies. If you are successful in applying for this visa, you will be able to work in any sector and at any skill level in the UK and when the two years are over, you can switch into skilled work visa routes if you find a suitable job and meet the requirements of the visa.

The Government has published a Fact Sheet, including Frequently-Asked-Questions, on the Graduate route.

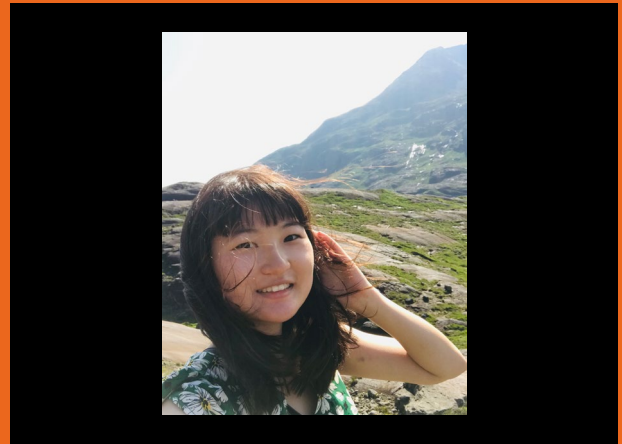

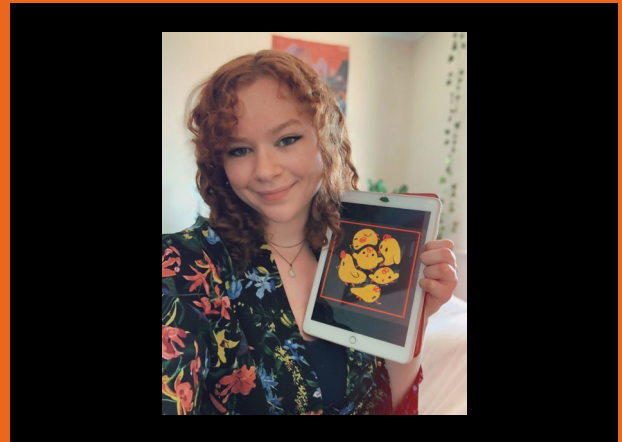

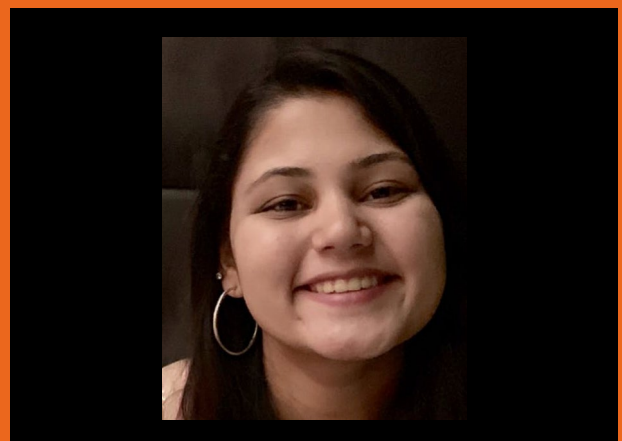
