## Foundation Diploma in Art, Design and Media

## International Foundation Diploma January Start

**Our undergraduate degrees offer you the opportunity to study an arts subject you love in a creative community, on a specialist campus.**



This is a fast-track course in Art, Design and Media, which includes an integrated programme of Preparation for Academic Study alongside the creative aspects of the course. The course helps students to develop their creative skills and produce a professional portfolio of work, ready to progress to a degree course within just 22 weeks. **aub.ac.uk/ffd**

**Animation Production**

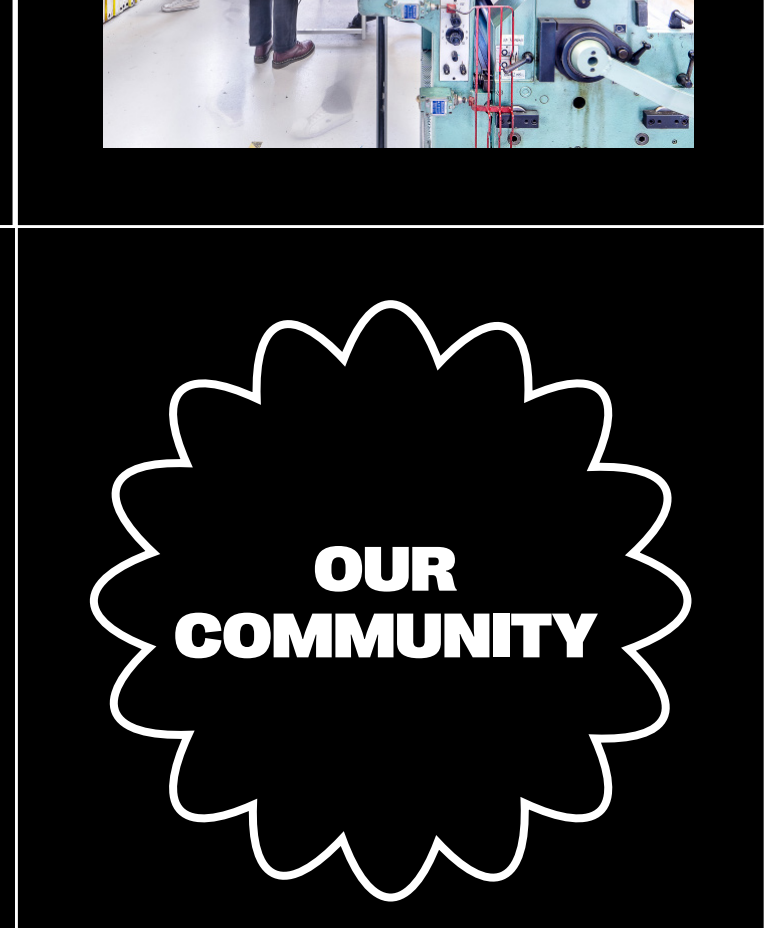

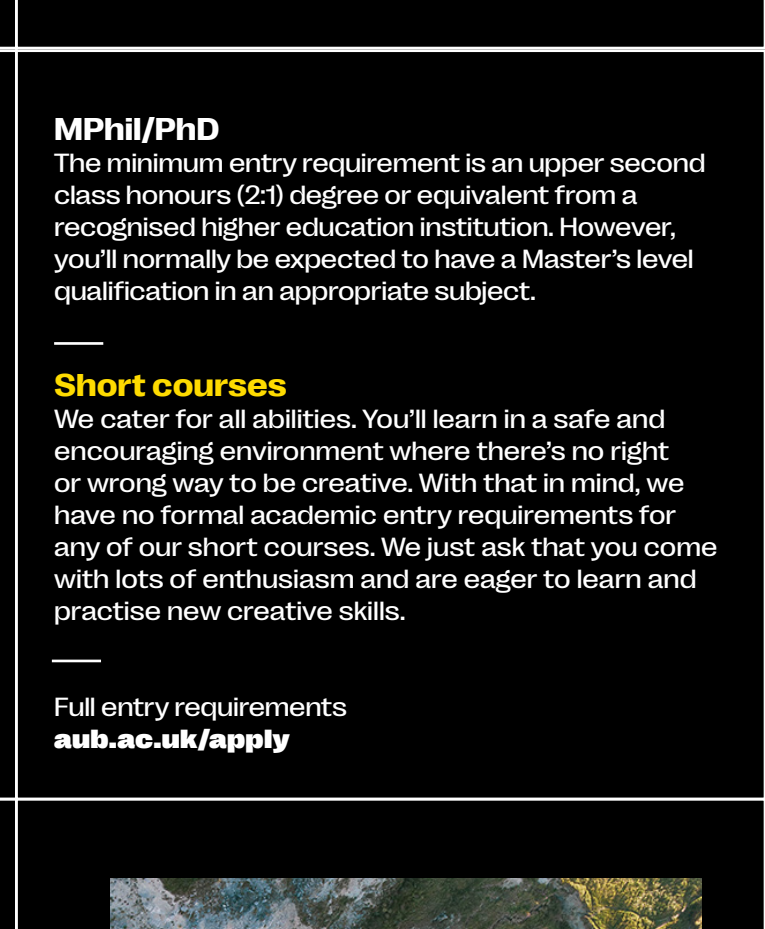

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

**Foundation**

Entry to a Foundation course usually follows two years of sixth form study, but we also consider relevant and equivalent Level 3 qualifications.

**Undergraduate**

All applicants must have Level 3 qualifications, which should include at least one creative subject. We're looking for between 112 and 120 UCAS Tariff points.

**Postgraduate**

We encourage application from students with a broad range of qualifications and we welcome students from all educational backgrounds. We'll take into account the knowledge and skills that you've developed outside the classroom as well as your previous qualifications.

**MPhil/PhD**

The minimum entry requirement is an upper second class honours (2:1) degree or equivalent from a recognised higher education institution. However, you'll normally be expected to have a Master's level qualification in an appropriate subject.

**Short courses**

We cater for all abilities. You'll learn in a safe and encouraging environment where there's no right or wrong way to be creative. With that in mind, we have no formal academic entry requirements for any of our short courses. We just ask that you come with lots of enthusiasm and are eager to learn and practice new creative skills.
