***Guidance update: Use of face coverings at Arts University Bournemouth (AUB)***

---

From 1 September, in order to maintain a safe environment at AUB, all campus visitors, staff and students will be required to wear face coverings while navigating indoor areas.

Face coverings can be removed where individuals are seated at designated areas or work stations, where the required physical distancing of 2m is in place at all times unless otherwise directed.

We recognise that some people may not be able to wear a face covering for legitimate reasons and we would ask all those on campus to be respectful of others, while continuing to practice safe physical distancing of 2m.

Technical and Academic staff will use clear visors while teaching and/or demonstrating in order to be understood and clearly heard by all students. AUB is continuously monitoring UK Government guidance, and will align our on-campus measures accordingly.
