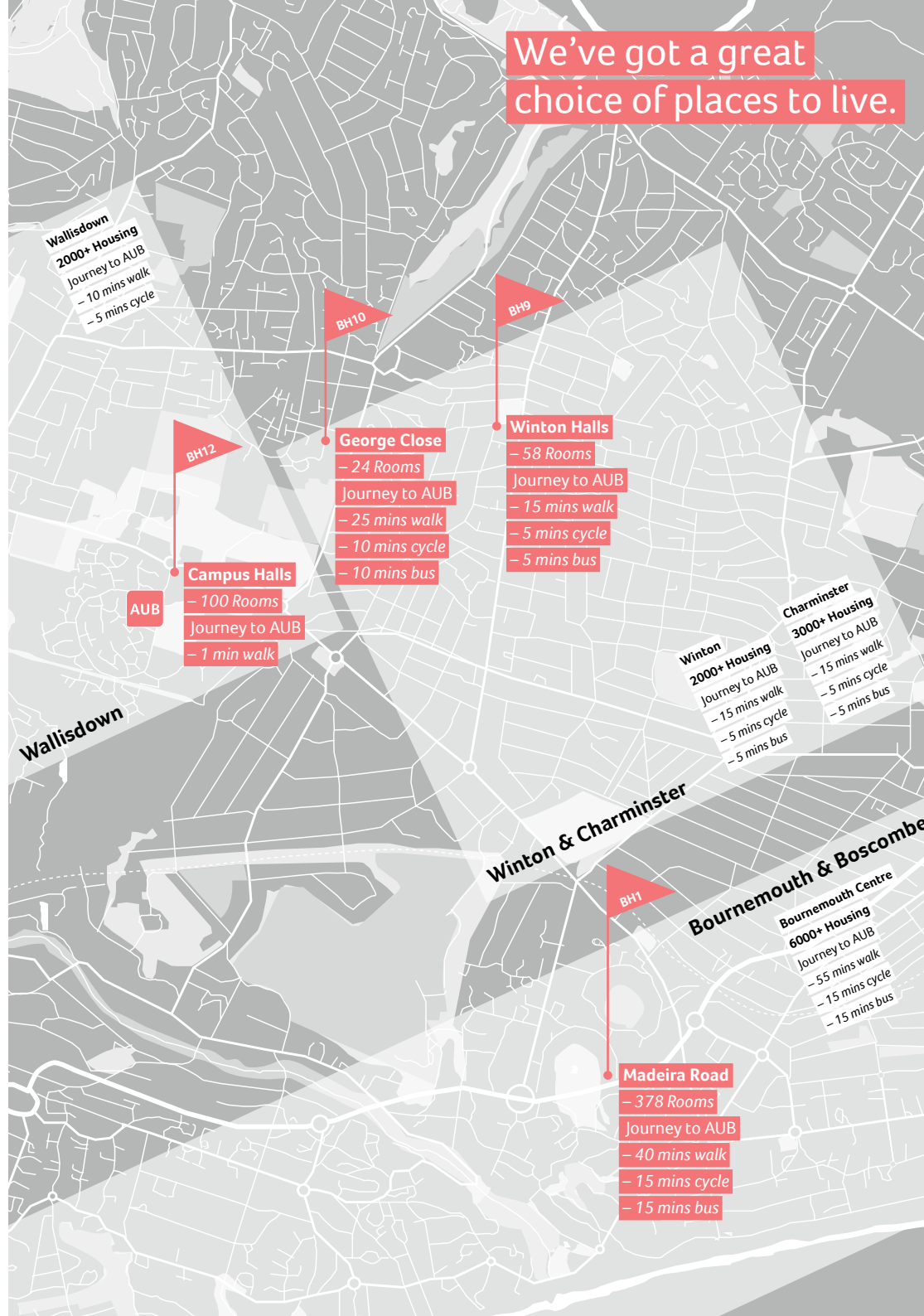
But don't hang around as there's a fair bit of demand for places.

## PLENTY OF CHOICE, LOTS OF DEMAND

We've mapped out the town you're going to enjoy over the next few years. Each hall is named after its Bournemouth postcode. Whichever one you choose there are regular buses to bring you home, well marked cycle routes for the flat (ish!) journey to AUB, and cycle racks to store your bike.

If you don't want to stay in halls, that's fine too. Many of our students live in shared rented housing in areas including Bournemouth, Boscombe, Winton, Charminster and Wallisdown. We will put you in touch with local landlords during our dedicated accommodation days.

## BH9 AND BH10

The best of both worlds can be found two miles away in Winton/Wallisdown. Our BH9 and BH10 halls are an easy walk to the AUB, but far enough away from campus to have an independent feel. ## BH12

For campus lovers our BH12 halls at AUB offer you the shortest walk to lectures in the morning! The 100 rooms always book up fast, and we prioritise international students and those with a disability. With all the facilities of AUB close to hand, BH12 halls are a great place to study and watch the university at work and play.

Our newest and biggest halls put you in the centre of Bournemouth, with an enviable range of bars, restaurants and clubs on your doorstep. AUB is an easy cycle, with regular buses too. As our largest hall there's a real buzz about the place and a great way to meet students studying other courses.
