

## **BA (Hons) Film Production**

### **Portfolio Guidelines**

Interviews are an opportunity for you to demonstrate to us your self-motivation and commitment to your area of study. We will be particularly interested in how you have responded to a given brief, together with any self-initiated projects.

We will expect to see contextual work, which can include a short five-minute film or showreel, or an extensive visual portfolio. Work which you have produced in your own time will not only strengthen your portfolio, but will display commitment, personal interest and demonstrate a wider appreciation of the visual arts.

Film is both a visual and an aural medium and we would expect to see evidence of ability in either or both of these areas.

*Your portfolio should include a range of the following:*

- A DVD showreel, of approximately five minutes, preferably showing video or film drama. Please provide with the showreel a separate information and credit sheet as we need to clearly identify your contribution to your work.
- A variety of written work showing examples of creative, academic or informative work.
- Photography folio
- Any research, scripts, storyboard, designs, schedules or drawings
