COURSE COSTS

BA (HONS) MAKE-UP FOR MEDIA AND PERFORMANCE

Make-up kits are essential – we recommend buying the course-devised kit that'll be ready for you to collect when you begin. This contains all the tools, materials and specialist products that reflect the freelance-style projects you'll work on during first and second year, with kit for make-up, wig making, hairdressing and prosthetics. It's worth noting we itemise your kit list to your needs, so there won't be any duplicates with equipment you already own.

Our **first-year** kit is competitively priced at around £1,000, suitable for professional and collaborative work both during and outside of your studies.

During **second year**, you'll specialise in prosthetics which will require a new, specific kit – we provide top-ups for this for around £200.

During **third year**, you'll be more independent by topping up your existing kits based on what you create, outlined in the Learning Agreement. The majority of third-year costs are covered due to projects being collaborative, like graduate films and live productions, which include a designated budget towards make-up artists and equipment.

As a result, these costs are individual – you could spend as little as £50 or over £200 based on what you create. If you'd like to find out more information about make-up kits, we discuss this at open and taster days, as well as all current costs.

During your time on BA (Hons) Make-up for Media and Performance, you'll be offered the chance to take part in optional **trips and visits** within and outside of the UK – these aren't compulsory and won't impact your grade if you can't attend. As an example, our last overseas course trip was to Budapest in 2023 and cost around £600 per student.

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
