

COURSE COSTS

BA (HONS) ANIMATION PRODUCTION

The fee that you pay the Arts University Bournemouth provides the necessary equipment and training for you to complete your course.

You may also choose to buy some items of personal equipment such as a laptop or tablet computer, but this is not required; desktop and laptop computers are available for you to use in common study areas, including a loan system in the Library.

It is not possible to be precise about the likely additional costs which you may incur, because this will depend on the choices you make and the projects you undertake. The University provides some basic materials, and you will be encouraged to work sustainably, and to re-use materials where possible, but you should still expect to make some financial investment. Most Level 4 and 5 students will be likely to spend around £350-500 per year on materials, although many will spend much less.

At Level 6 you will undertake your major project, and your portfolio of work will be important as you progress to a creative career. Each graduate production will have its own production budget covered by the course. This budget is usually sufficient to cover the costs of production. Fundraising is an option should your production require additional funds to those provided.

This course offers educational visits within the UK. Some of these are compulsory and the cost will be partially subsidised by the course. The cost will depend on the nature of the visit and sometimes you may be asked to pay a small fee towards covering the cost of entry fees. This course did not offer an overseas trip last year.
