

COURSE COSTS

BA (HONS) ART AND DESIGN HISTORY

The fee that you pay the Arts University Bournemouth provides the necessary equipment and training for you to complete your course.

You may also choose to buy some items of personal equipment such as a laptop or tablet computer, but this is not required; desktop and laptop computers are available for you to use in common study areas, including a loan system in the Library.

It is not possible to be precise about the likely additional costs which you may incur, because this will depend on the choices you make and the projects you undertake. You will be encouraged to work sustainably, but you may find that you wish to purchase certain books or other resources, and you should still expect to make some financial investment. It is likely that students of BA (Hons) Art and Design History will spend less than £200 a year.

Some courses offer educational visits, which may be within the UK or abroad. These are not compulsory, and you will not be disadvantaged if you do not take part. The cost will depend on the location of the visit. As this is a new course, we are unable to provide details of previous educational visits run by this course, and the course has not currently planned any educational visits for 2019/20. Costs of these visits can vary from £300 for a trip to Paris to £750 for a trip to New York, but you will of course be given good notice of any plans.
