How to make a direct application

Making a direct application to AUB

If you're applying for our Foundation course, International Foundation Diploma (IFD) or one of our postgraduate MA courses, you should apply to us directly online.

If you're an EU or Overseas student and you're applying for a full-time undergraduate BA course, you can apply to us directly, free of charge.


Please note we can only consider direct online applications if you haven't applied and won't apply through UCAS for this year of entry. If you're applying to more than one university in the UK, you should apply through UCAS. However, if you're only applying to AUB, we'd recommend that you apply directly to us.

Before You Apply

Before starting your application, make sure you have all the essential information need to complete it. Ensure you include all of the qualifications that you have and are currently taking. You can also tell us about any work experience that you've done.

In your personal statement, we'd like to know more about why you're interested in the course, the key influences on your work and what you hope to do after your studies.

Once you know the course you want to apply for, go to the *How to Apply* pages of our website.

Click on the coloured tile 'Apply Directly', a window will open with information about the direct application process and a link to the online Direct Application form.
