## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Incoming exchange applications are assessed individually by the relevant Course Leader and a decision is made primarily on the content and quality of the portfolio of work.



**LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION**

All teaching is in English.  
All incoming exchange students are expected to have a level of English language equivalent to a minimum overall IELTS score of 6.0.
