

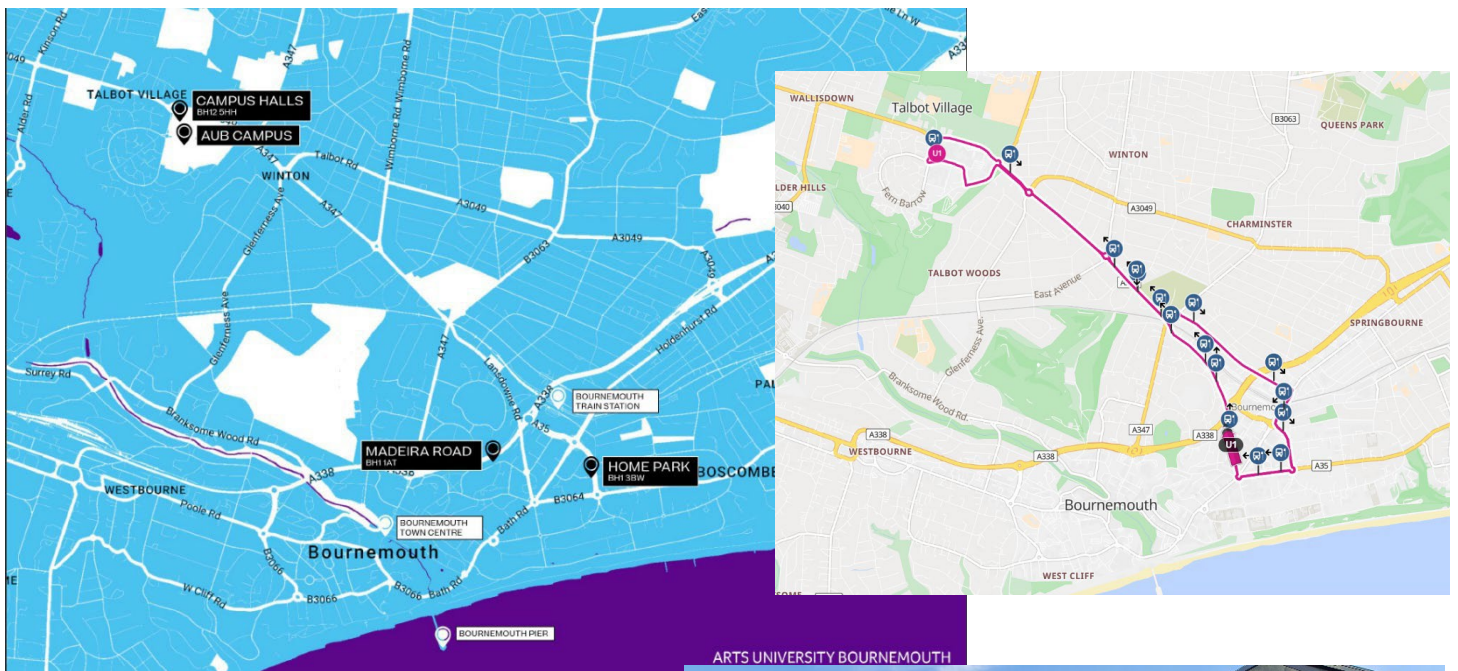

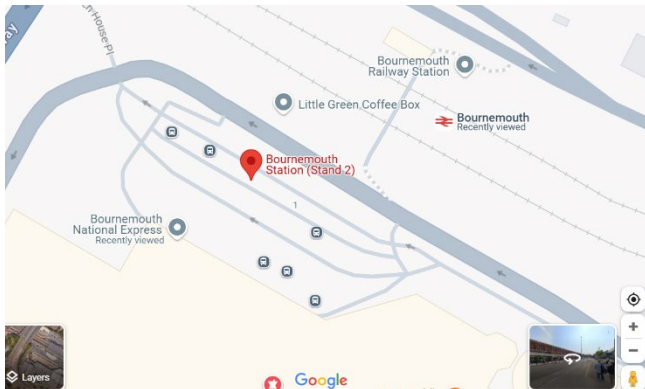
Arriving by Train or Coach

Both are located at the Train Station

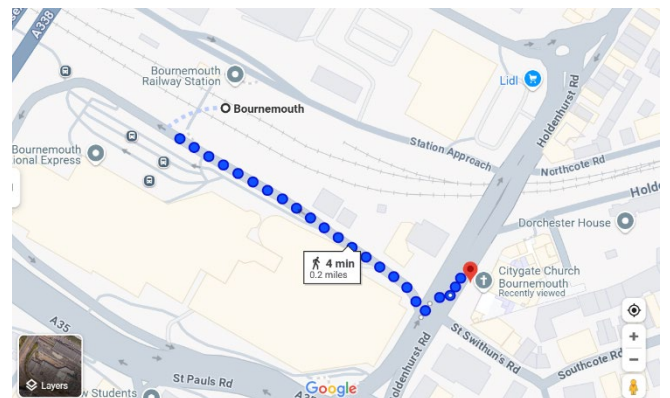


← This is what you will see as you come out on the Train Station side.

On the Coach Station side



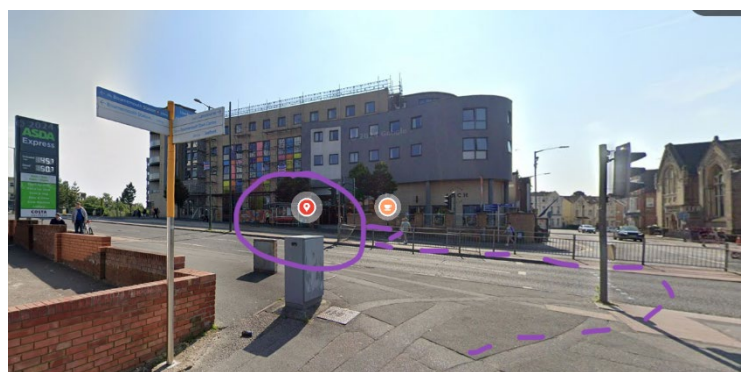
Option 1:
