APPLYING FOR YOUR FUNDING

PrepHE (Foundation) Students (UK/EU)

As a PrepHE (Foundation) student there are several different funding options that may be available to you based on your household income. Bursaries include: Discretionary Bursaries, Residential Bursaries and free meals for students 16-18 and the Advanced Learning Loan Bursary for students 19+ who are in receipt of the Advanced Learner Loan.

All applications can be made online after you have fully enrolled and you will be provided with more information at that time.

Please note that funds are limited and eligibility does not guarantee that funding will be available. For more information, please visit aub.ac.uk/funding

You can prepare to apply for PrepHE bursaries by having the following information:

- A copy of your term time tenancy agreement if you are moving away from home in order to attend the course.
- Confirmation from your Local Authority if you are living in care or have lived in care for more than 13 weeks since the age of 14.
- Evidence from your parents, or yourself if you are being independently assessed:
 - Previous two months bank statements.
 - P60 or evidence of annual income, if self-employed.
 - Evidence of any benefits claimed.
 - Evidence of any other income (i.e. pension, tax credits). If you provide the complete tax credit award notice (all pages), you do not need to provide evidence of your annual income.
 - Evidence of childcare costs (if applicable).

Degree Students (UK)

If you are studying your first degree, are receiving the full maintenance loan and are domiciled in England, you may be eligible for Additional Support.

Students identified as eligible for Additional Support will be contacted in the Autumn Term and invited to apply for any applicable bursaries or vouchers.

All applications can be made online after you have enrolled and you will be provided with more information at that time.

Degree Students (International and EU)

If, during your time at AUB, you are in financial hardship due to unforeseen circumstances, please visit Student Services to discuss your situation and receive more information of your options.
