### TRAVELLING TO OUR OPEN DAY

#### Arriving by Car

If you are arriving by car, please follow directions to the University where car parking will be clearly signposted. For SatNav please use postcode BH12 5HH. Full directions can be found on our website.

**NB** Car parking on campus is limited.

#### Arriving by Train, Coach or Bus

Frequent coach and train services operate to Bournemouth from many large towns and cities. All of these methods of public transport arrive at the Bournemouth Travel Interchange which is located in the Lansdowne area of Bournemouth.

#### Transfer by Public Bus

Local buses will be available to transfer you from the Bournemouth Travel Interchange to the University Campus. Yellow buses number U6 operate a route to the University. Please visit [bybus.co.uk](http://bybus.co.uk) for the timetable information.

#### Private Taxi Transfers

Alternatively if you wish to travel by taxi transfer, the journey from the Bournemouth Travel Interchange to the University Campus will take approximately 10 minutes.

### PROGRAMME DETAILS

#### Campus Tours

Students currently studying at the University will lead general tours of the campus throughout the day (Zone 7). Tours will be limited to group sizes of 15–20 people and last approx 20 minutes.

#### Local Area Bus Tours

Complimentary bus tours of the local area will be departing at 30 minute intervals from 09.00 onwards (50 minute tours). Please collect a ticket upon arrival from Zone 7 (subject to availability).

The tour will include the town centre, seafront and areas of student accommodation. The tour will not include visitation inside our Halls of Residence.

**NB** Please note tickets are limited to one student and one guest only.

#### Print Workshop

Join AUB Alumni in the print room and try your hand at screenprinting or linoprinting, and create something to take home with you (Zone 6). Perfect for all the family!

An informative talk covering fees, finance and student accommodation (30 minutes). These talks are repeated four times during the event.

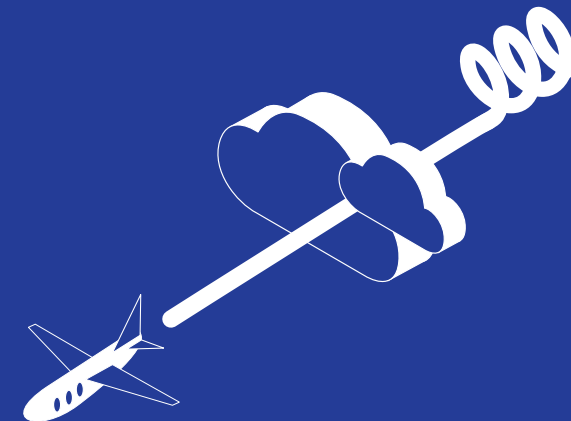
