PROFESSOR SIR CHRISTOPHER FRAYLING CHANCELLOR

Professor Sir Christopher Frayling is a British educationalist, writer, broadcaster and a global champion of the arts and design.

Sir Christopher read History at Churchill College, Cambridge, where he gained his PhD and was subsequently appointed as a Fellow of Churchill College in 2009. He had a long association with the Royal College of Art (RCA), joining it in 1973 as a part-time tutor and becoming its Professor of Cultural History in 1979. He became Rector of the RCA in 1996 until his retirement in 2009.

Sir Christopher became renowned for his interviews with such global creative figures as Clint Eastwood, Martin Scorsese, and Umberto Eco. He remains a prolific writer and broadcaster for radio and television, his subjects range from the work of Sergio Leone and spaghetti westerns, to advertising in his television series *The Art of Persuasion* to the importance of craftsmanship and design.

Sir Christopher was the Chairman of Arts Council England from 2004 until January 2009. He also served as Chairman of the Design Council, Chairman of the Royal Mint Advisory Committee, and is a long-serving Trustee of the Victoria and Albert Museum, London.

He was a Governor of the British Film Institute in the 1980s. In 2001, he was awarded a knighthood for 'Services to Art and Design Education'.

Sir Christopher was installed as the inaugural Chancellor of Arts University Bournemouth in April 2014.



Dorothy Mackenzie is Chair of the University Board.

Since co-founding the London office of global creative, brand and design agency Dragon Rouge in 1991, Dorothy Mackenzie has championed and promoted sustainability within the creative industry.

Dorothy has been at the forefront of concepts like the circular revolution, which explores how waste and pollution in design can be minimised with pioneering recycling, reuse and regeneration systems.

Dorothy is a Non-Executive Director at Carbon Trust, which partners with businesses, organisations and governments around the world to accelerate the move to a decarbonised future.

CLARY SALANDY MBE, RDI HONORARY FELLOW

Clary is known for her innovative designs and strong community links within the world of Carnival. She is the Artistic Director and Designer for Mahogany Carnival Design, which she co-founded with structural engineer Michael Ramdeen (Speedy) and associates in 1989.

Clary designs costumes with a message that challenge common stereotypes, while training artists and developing carnivals nationally and internationally.

As a seminal force in Carnival arts for over 35 years, Mahogany have won many awards for staged and street spectacles. They are consecutive winners at the Notting Hill Carnival and the London New Year’s Day parade.

Clary was Artistic Director for the Coronation segment of the Queen’s Platinum Jubilee Pageant. She was awarded the title Honorary Royal Designer for Industry by the RSA in 2024. She is also the Industry Patron for AUB’s BA (Hons) Events Management course.

Clary is committed to keeping a spotlight on the art of Mas working across diverse cultural celebrations within a spirit of carnival that unites us all.



SOPHIE DEEN HONORARY FELLOW

Sophie Deen is founder of Bright Little Labs, a Warner Bros.-backed children’s media company creating books and animations focused on 21st century skills.

Through her work, she makes digital literacy, creativity, and critical thinking accessible to children through diverse, engaging storytelling.

Her flagship series, *Agent Asha*, follows a young coder and spy working for the Children’s Spy Agency, whose motto “Think for yourself, question everything” captures Sophie’s educational philosophy.

Sophie began her career as a lawyer, working in deep tech, and helping introduce the computing curriculum to UK schools alongside Google and the Department for Education. Today, she advises the UK government on AI and technology innovation.

Her work has earned accolades including Creative Industries Entrepreneur of the Year and recognition among Computer Weekly’s Most Influential Women in UK Tech. At the heart of everything Sophie does is a vision: empowering children to become creators, not just consumers, of technology and their world.



ROMA AGRAWAL MBE
HONORARY FELLOW

Roma Agrawal MBE is an engineer, author and broadcaster who is best known for working on the design of The Shard, Western Europe's tallest tower. Roma has given talks to tens of thousands at universities, schools and organisations around the world, including TEDx. She has also presented numerous TV, radio and podcast shows for the BBC, Channel 4 and Discovery.

Her first book, *BUILT* (2018) has won multiple awards, and she published an extremely successful children's version, *HOW WAS THAT BUILT?* in 2021. Her third book, *NUTS & BOLTS* was out in early 2023, and was shortlisted for the prestigious Royal Society Trivedi Science Book Prize.

Roma has been learning various dance forms since she was six, practises yoga and pilates, is an avid knitter and crocheter, and has even dabbled in stand-up comedy.

Elspeth has been the CEO of the South West's largest Arts Centre since 2009. Lighthouse delivers a broad, diverse programme of 1,000 live music, theatre, dance, films and exhibitions each year. She has steered the organisation through many challenges and delivered a £5 million refurbishment. She produces the Lighthouse pantomime, which attracts 20,000 people each year and has won several national awards.

Elspeth's career has predominantly been with nationally significant cultural landmark venues: Interim Director of Theatre Management at English National Opera; Project Director (re-opening) of the £116 million refurbishment of the Royal Festival Hall in 2005; Head of Programme Planning at Southbank Centre, Head of Programming at Fairfield Halls, Croydon and Entertainment Officer for the London Borough of Lambeth.

Elspeth holds a degree in Performing Arts from the University of Kent (Canterbury), where she specialised in theatre directing and music. She is an enthusiastic novice sailor and a trustee of the Scaramouche Sailing Trust, supporting diversity in sailing.

Grace Gorman is an accomplished hair and make-up artist whose career spans theatre, film, and television. She began as a wig maker in London after graduating and toured internationally with *Priscilla, Queen of the Desert* and *Sunny Afternoon*. She then moved over to the West End, working on *42nd Street* at Theatre Royal Drury Lane, *The King and I* at the Palladium as deputy head of wigs, and *Wicked*, looking after Glinda and Elphaba during its 11th year.

In 2018, Grace transitioned to screen, working on productions such as *Matilda*, *The Crown*, *Cruella*, *Downton Abbey*, and *Bridgerton* – where she was part of the Emmy-winning team for Season 2 and styled three leads in Season 3. That season has earned a BAFTA nomination and won the Make-up Artists and Hairstylists Guild Award. She also worked as a full-time artist on *Wicked* Parts 1 and 2, which was nominated for an Oscar in best make-up and hair styling. Most recently, she has been working on a TV series in Prague as personal hair stylist to Hannah Waddingham.

Ilshio Lovejoy has built a career deeply committed to advancing labour-centred industry transitions and fostering fair, inclusive industry practices. With a background spanning NGOs, academia, brands, and suppliers, she has worked across the fashion and textiles ecosystem to bridge the gap between business responsibility and the wellbeing of both workers and the planet.

Throughout her work, she has supported policy advancement, industry environmental improvements, and the agency and inclusion of marginalised supply chain actors and workers. From grant-making in her current role, to managing business impacts in the private sector, and advocating for policies and practices with NGOs, she has worked to drive meaningful progress towards socially and environmentally sustainable industries.

She recently completed her Master's in Social Innovation at the Cambridge Judge Business School and is motivated to bridge the gap between academic knowledge and industry practice in pursuit of fair and just transitions to net zero.

THE MACE



The Mace

The Mace is carried by a graduate of the University who leads the Vice-Chancellor and Academic Procession at the start of the ceremony. The Mace symbolises the authority and independence of the University and the authority it derives from the Privy Council to award degrees. The Mace is the work of the eminent craftsman and designer, John Makepeace OBE, who is an Honorary Fellow of Arts University Bournemouth. The Mace is made from ripple sycamore and comprises of 80 leaves reaching up to a silver crown. It represents the growth and realisation of knowledge.

John Makepeace received the Prince Philip Designers Prize in 2016.

The Macebearer

BA (Hons) Architecture graduate Rebecca Smith is a chartered architect at Western Design Architects, where she has been since graduating from AUB in 2018. Her passion for collaboration and research has seen her win multiple awards, including the Dean’s Prize and the Nicholas Durbridge Award at AUB, plus the Martin Pearce Award at postgraduate level. In 2022, Rebecca received an RIBA Wren Scholarship, awarded to those with the potential to make a significant contribution to architecture. In 2023, she was part of a team who were longlisted for the Davidson Prize, an ideas competition that addresses homelessness and housing insecurity.

Rebecca was elected Chair of the Dorset RIBA branch in 2025. In practice, she focuses on excellence in sustainability and enjoys working across a range of sectors, including luxury homes, master planning, heritage and community schemes. She has a passion for working with young people, both in schools and at university, delivering work experience programmes and career events. She oversees the RIBA mentoring programme in practice and is a regular guest critic for AUB’s BA (Hons) Architecture course.

Elliot Warren: From stage to Spielberg

BA (Hons) Acting graduate, Elliot Warren, won a career crown jewel – the Olivier Award for Outstanding Achievement in an Affiliate Theatre – in 2019 for his play *Flesh and Bone*. The play tells the story of a family living in an East End tower block facing demolition, incorporating rap, grime, Tarantino-esque dialogue, and Shakespearean language.

As an actor, Elliot’s had roles in the acclaimed *Masters of the Air* (produced by Steven Spielberg and Tom Hanks) and *How to Have Sex* (the BAFTA-nominated brainchild of fellow AUB alum Molly Manning Walker), as well as appearances in *A Thousand Blows* on Disney+, and the ninth series of ITV’s crime drama *Grantchester*.

He’s also had multiple writing projects on the go for television including *X*, which began filming in 2024, his feature film *Bruiser*, and his original series *SlaughterHouse*, a six-part drama in development with the BBC. Set in Essex, *SlaughterHouse* is about working-class ‘boy racers’ as well as about young men who are dealing with depression, anxiety and suicide.

Off the screen, Elliot’s second play, *The Ballad of Ticky Monroe*, is in the early stages of writing. Following a similar vein of *Flesh and Bone*, the play’s written in a rhyming slang-Shakespearean verse hybrid.



A rising star of street photography

Since graduating in the summer of 2024, BA (Hons) Commercial Photography alumnus Ethan Parker has already been on the cover of *Amateur Photographer* magazine (plus a three-page Q&A feature inside), secured several nominations in the British Photography Awards and won the People’s Choice Street Photography Award with his photo *The Euros*. This same image also gained him a place in the finals in the street photography category at the Independent Photographer Awards.

A lot of Ethan’s recognition has been for his work in street photography, which he started shooting when he was doing his A-Levels. He says that accomplishing so much in so short a time has been a little bit surreal and that it was never his plan to try and get his name out there straight away. On the plus side, all the attention has given him confidence and reassured him that he’s doing the right thing.

As Ethan began shooting more and more street photography, he saw the everyday moments that usually get completely missed by people walking around. Ethan feels like he’s duty-bound to document how we live now, and having a camera gives him the ability to capture those moments and record them.

British Council Award for film sparking debates on social issues

An international student at AUB, Kajri Babbar, was recognised with an award in the cultural and creativity category of the British Council Study UK Alumni Awards for her documentary film work aimed at sparking debates on pressing social issues.

AUB MA Film Practice graduate Kajri has had works screened at the Student Academy Awards, the Cannes Film Festival and now she’s making her feature film directorial debut with *Lioness*, the first-ever official UK-India co-production.

Lioness tells the stories of two women living centuries apart. The first story unravels the life and legacy of Sophia Duleep Singh, a prominent suffragette who fervently advocated for women’s rights in the UK. The second story introduces a fictional character, Simranjeet Kaur, living in London’s Southall Asian suburb in the early 1990s.

Kajri was thinking about coming to the UK to go to RADA, but her father wasn’t keen. As he’s a film producer in India, they compromised, and she came to the UK on a scholarship to do an MA in Film Practice at AUB instead.

KYRA GIBSON

Fashion graduate hired for AUB’s first Knowledge Transfer Partnership

AUB Fashion alumna Kyra Gibson was appointed to work on the University’s first Knowledge Transfer Partnership (KTP) in 2025. A KTP is a UK Government scheme funded by UK Research and Innovation (UKRI) through Innovate UK, the government’s innovation agency. KTPs link forward-thinking businesses with the UK’s world-class knowledge bases to deliver innovation projects led by inspired graduates.

This KTP’s aim was to digitally transform high-performance outerwear clothing brand, ThruDark, and to deliver a new product development process realising growth potential and reducing carbon footprint.

Kyra has always loved being involved with new, cutting-edge projects and technologies. As soon as she graduated from AUB in 2021, Kyra secured a digital innovation intern role at AUB’s Innovation Studio, where she led a research and development project, helped run VR workshops, and started to run body scanning workshops. From here, Kyra went on to Burberry where she was a 3D technologist working within product engineering in the supply chain to utilise digital fashion technologies.

Now, Kyra is working with AUB and ThruDark to improve the productivity of new product development, improve garment fit and therefore reduce the number of product returns by 35%, whilst also reducing the number of samples required to develop new products by 50%.





AUB Modelmaking students stars of the show with 14 award wins at New Blades 2024

BA (Hons) Modelmaking students from Arts University (AUB) were the stars of 2024’s New Blades show in London, winning 14 awards of a possible 21. The annual modelmaking recruitment exposition is the single most important event of the year for budding modelmakers providing a space for recruiters to meet new and emerging talent.

Organised by 4Dmodelshop and sponsored by a host of industry employers including Foster + Partners, Amalgam, M.A.D Models, Merlin Magic Making, ATOM, and others, 2024 was the 30th annual show at Holborn Studios in London. Hundreds of industry guests visited to see the work of this year’s graduating modelmakers from universities across the UK.

Ed Allen came away with four awards including the Best of Show Award, Most Ingenious Award, ‘Outside the Box’ Award and Best Product Model Award. Katrine Linderoth was another of the night’s big winners scooping the Leviathan Workshop Award, Fixie’s Best Use of 3D Printing Award, and the Best Use of Creative Materials Award.

Immy Hughes won the Best of Show Runner-up Award and the Best Model Making Award, while Best Architectural Model Award went to Joan Serra Bofill, and The Richard Gregory SFX Award went to Charlotte Couch. The Sustainability Award was won by Sally Feast, Sam Carroll won the M.A.D Models Award, and the Pretty Cool Award was won by Anthony Edgar.

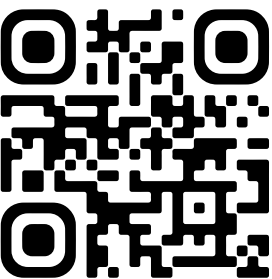
The Pavilion Theatre and Ballroom

Advocated as early as 1859, proposals for a Pavilion building incorporating a concert room, reading rooms and cafes were first authorised by the municipal authorities in 1892. The architectural competition was won by a young and unknown firm of architects called Home and Knight.

On 19 March 1929, the building was opened by HRH The Duke of Gloucester. The building is Grade II listed.

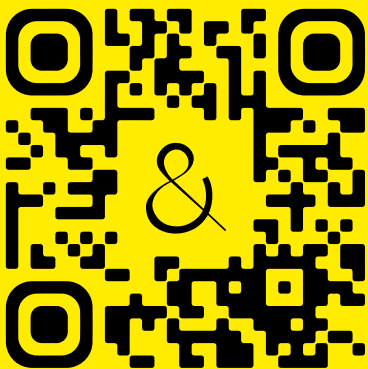
