

ARE DEPOSITS NECESSARY?

Students who require a visa to enter the UK will be asked to pay £1,500 in advance as a deposit (which will be deducted from your tuition fee) so that we can issue a confirmation of acceptance for studies (CAS). All Postgraduate students have to pay a terms deposit by a set point in September.

CHANGE OF STATUS FROM INTERNATIONAL (NON-EU) STATUS TO UK/EU STUDENT

The University has a target number of students for both UK/EU and International students. This number cannot be exceeded and on popular courses the target number of students is achieved early in the application year. Therefore if you have been interviewed and accepted for a course of study as an International (non-EU) student and then request to change your status you will have to reapply as an UK/EU student as your place cannot be guaranteed within a different target category.

PROGRESSION DISCOUNTS

An additional 5% reduction will apply to each year of a BA (Hons) degree for students who have undertaken a pre-degree course at the University (*providing that there is not a break in study and that the fee is paid in full and in advance each year by the set deadline*).

An additional 20% reduction will apply to the MA course fee for students who have undertaken a degree level course at the University and progressed to Postgraduate level study (*providing the fee is paid in full and in advance by the set deadline*).

SCHOLARSHIPS

There are a limited number of Post Graduate Scholarships available. For more details please refer to the website.

WHAT DO THESE TUITION FEES INCLUDE?

These fees cover all teaching of up to 18 hours per week (depending on the course) plus access to full facilities and resources during the term-time opening hours. Accommodation and living costs should be calculated separately. Living in Bournemouth is much cheaper than London and students should allow approximately £6,000 to £8,000 per year. All students are also invited to the orientation programmes which are arranged by the International Office.

The University supports research degree students to undertake research methodology training at the University of the Arts London.

ARE THERE ANY OTHER CHARGES?

All Diploma students have to pay a yearly charge to contribute towards the materials for their course. In 2013 – 2014 this fee ranged from £155 - £195 depending on the course and the level of resources required. You will be informed of the exact amount due when you have accepted your place. There are no materials fees for Higher Education students as the course team will provide some of the basic requirements. You will however be responsible for the costs of your own materials for project work throughout your course. These costs will vary between subject areas, and the course team can advise you on the likely costs of your chosen course. Please note that BA (Hons) Make-up for Media and Performance requires specialist kits to be purchased in the first term and the cost is approximately £800.

There is also a registration fee for the Foundation Diploma and Extended Diploma programmes. Last year these did not exceed £180. The registration fees are payable once at the beginning of the course and are required for the validating body.
