

INTERNATIONAL (NON-EU) STUDENTS

APPLYING

Applying to AUB is simple. You can make an online application at aub.ac.uk/apply. You'll find step by step instructions at aub.ac.uk/intapply and if you need more help, email us at international@aub.ac.uk.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS, ENGLISH LANGUAGE AND PORTFOLIOS

Applicants will usually have a 2:1 or equivalent undergraduate level qualification but, most importantly, will be interested in experimentation and innovative practice within a structured framework leading to Masters outcomes. International applicants must also hold a relevant English language qualification.

Portfolio guides for each course can also be found on the website on each programme overview page.

You'll find our IELTS English language requirements below, but you should visit aub.ac.uk/english to confirm the category of test that you need for your level of study and to see which other qualifications we accept. You'll also find details of our pre-sessional English courses in the English section of the website.

ACCOMMODATION

New international students have priority when halls allocations are made, as long as you've applied by the set deadline (usually towards the end of May). We also offer a free taxi collection from the airport for new international (non-EU) students.

VISA INFORMATION

If you're from a country outside the EU, EEA or Switzerland, you'll need a Visa or entry clearance to study in the UK. If you'll be studying a full-time course, longer than 6 months, you'll need a Tier 4 (General) Visa. Our campus is just two miles from Bournemouth town centre, on the border between Bournemouth and Poole.


If you're travelling by train, you can get from Bournemouth to London in less than two hours. For a detailed map and directions visit aub.ac.uk/findus

MA FILM PRODUCTION


Eligible for scholarship*

The MA Film Production course is for talented and emerging filmmakers seeking to learn through making, to look beyond the short film, to define themselves as artists within film production and to gain that vital experience demanded by the industry.

On the course there will be opportunities to collaborate, to research and to develop projects together with other filmmakers that can extend beyond the course and into the industry.

MA GRAPHIC DESIGN

The MA Graphic Design course encourages designers to explore ways of developing understanding between co-communicators.

You will do this by systematically interrogating design practice, through using design methods to analyse and comprehend situations and behaviour and by generating alternative and novel visual solutions.

The MA Commercial Photography course offers you the opportunity to enhance your practice with the aim of becoming a photographer at the forefront of the industry.

MA Commercial Photography students will be engaged in a breadth of creative practice including advertising, fashion, editorial and documentary photography, with a strong emphasis on freelance working.

MASTERS OF ARCHITECTURE (ARB/RIBA PART 2)

Eligible for scholarship*

AUB's RIBA accredited MArch explores the possibilities of new architectural practices that make, innovate and collaborate, exploring diverse processes of community development and transformation.

The two year MArch course broadens and deepens the architect's range of activities, and empowers its community through its members' ability to actually make a difference.

MA Fine Art is an opportunity to look at the familiar with a fresh, perhaps oblique perspective in order to explore how "detour" permits "access" (Jullien 2004) to more subtle yet more complex interpretations. What constitutes a meaningful and useful research methodology in one culture may be considered unknown, unnecessary or redundant in another methodologies.
