Portfolios Requirements

As an applicant of the MA Fine Art Course at the Arts University Bournemouth you will be assessed on your existing qualities as demonstrated in your portfolio and at interview.

The MA Fine Art course is broad-based in its approach and we offer distinctive and exciting opportunities for students to engage in their respective subject discipline. We therefore endeavour to accommodate the broadest range of student work possible and do not set parameters on the nature of work to be submitted, encouraging diversity in applications from international and UK candidates.

Typically, a portfolio may include documentation of 2D or 3D work, text, performance, video or sound. We look for evidence of creativity and enquiry and the potential for developing Masters level research, and to contribute and benefit from the student experience this course has to offer.

Applicants who are unable to attend interview will be requested to submit a link to an online portfolio; full details of how to submit this will be sent to you from Admissions once your application has been received.
