## TRAVELLING TO OUR OPEN DAY

#### ARRIVING BY CAR

## ARRIVING BY TRAIN, COACH OR BUS

Frequent coach and train services operate to Bournemouth from many large towns and cities. All of these methods of public transport arrive at the Bournemouth Travel Interchange which is located in the Lansdowne area of Bournemouth.

## TRANSFER BY PUBLIC BUS
