### TRAVELLING TO OUR OPEN DAY

#### Arriving by Car

If you are travelling to Bournemouth by car, please use our Park and Ride scheme, as parking on the campus **will not** be available.

Our Park and Ride scheme operates from The Bournemouth International Centre (BIC), which is located in the centre of town. The Open Day Travel Map provides clear instructions on locating the BIC.

We understand the importance of choosing the right degree course and University, but also believe that location plays a big role in affecting your choice and decision. That's why, as part of our Park and Ride scheme we are offering parking at the BIC, allowing you sufficient time to experience our Open Day whilst providing you with an opportunity to explore Bournemouth town.

Please note that free parking is subject to **a valid parking permit**, allowing you to park your vehicle in the BIC car park from 08.30-17.30. Approximately 250 spaces will be available at the BIC which we anticipate should be sufficient. However, alternative car parking will be available at nearby 'pay to park' car parks, these are highlighted on our Open Day Travel Map.

Registration for the Open Day will take place in the foyer of the BIC, where you will be issued with a welcome pack before boarding a coach for complimentary transfer to the University College Campus.

Please note that if you were unable to print or have mislaid your parking permit, spares will be available at our registration desk within the BIC.

#### **Shuttle transfer service from the BIC to the University College Campus**

*Departing at the following approximate times: Morning programme (10.30 session) 09.00, 09.25, 09.40, 09.50, 10.00 and 10.10.*

Please note: If you are booked onto the 10.30 Course Talk session we would recommend arriving at the BIC **no later** than 09.30 to ensure you have sufficient time for registration and transfer to the University College campus.

*Afternoon programme (13.30 session) 12.00, 12.25, 12.40, 12.50 and 13.00 and 13.10.*

If you are booked onto the 13.30 Course Talk session we recommend arriving at the BIC no later than 12.30 to ensure you have sufficient time for registration and transfer to the University College campus.

Shuttle transfer service from the University College Campus to the BIC  
*Departing at the following approximate times: 13.00, 13.50, 14.15, 15.00, 15.30, 15.55, 16.20, and 17.00.*

Arriving by Train, Coach or Bus:  
Frequent coach and train services operate to Bournemouth from many large towns and cities. All of these methods of public transport arrive at the Bournemouth Travel Interchange which is located in the Lansdowne area of Bournemouth.

#### Transfer by Public Bus

Local buses will be available to transfer you from the Bournemouth Travel Interchange to the University College Campus.

Yellow Buses numbers 6a, 6b or 6c operate a route to the University College. Please visit [www.bybus.co.uk](http://www.bybus.co.uk) for timetable information.

#### Private Taxi Transfers

Alternatively if you wish to travel by taxi transfer, the journey from the Bournemouth Travel Interchange to the University College Campus will take approximately 5-10 minutes.

Once you have arrived at the Campus, please make your way to Reception where you will need to register your attendance. Please arrive at least 30 mins prior to the commencement of the Course Talk session you are booked on (10.30 or 13.30 hours).
