TRAVELLING TO OUR OPEN DAY

SHUTTLE SERVICE

Car parking is limited on campus therefore
we recommend using our complimentary
shuttle service. The shuttle bus will transfer
you from Lansdowne Road (near Co-op) to
AUB campus. The shuttle bus will operate
every 15 minutes between 09:00-16:15.
Please refer to the map provided for further
information.

ARRIVING BY CAR

If you are arriving by car, please follow
directions to the University where car
parking will be clearly signposted. For
SatNav please use postcode: BH12 5HH.
Full directions can be found on our website.
Please note, car parking on campus
is limited.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN, COACH OR BUS

Frequent coach and train services operate
to Bournemouth from many large towns
and cities. All of these methods of public
transport arrive at the Bournemouth
Travel Interchange which is located in the
Lansdowne area of Bournemouth.

TRANSFER BY PUBLIC BUS

Local buses will be available to transfer you
from the Bournemouth Travel Interchange
to the University Campus. Yellow buses
number 6 operate a route to the University.

PRIVATE TAXI TRANSFERS

Alternatively if you wish to travel by
taxi transfer, the journey from the
Bournemouth Travel Interchange
to the University campus will take
approximately 10 minutes.
