Undergraduate (Degree) Students

(All BA (Hons) courses – first year entry)

The minimum entry requirement for a degree is an overall IELTS score of 6.0.

The University College is therefore asking every student to obtain IELTS 6.0 with a minimum score of 5.5 in each of the 4 components (Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening) or attend the 8 week General Intensive Course and the 5 week Pre-Sessional course. If you cannot undertake the course for a certain length of time or wish to study elsewhere, you will need to meet our recommended level of English to obtain an unconditional place.

Please note the University College accepts a range of English language tests including TOEFL and Pearson.

The University College has assessed your English language results and we recommend that you attend the 8 week General Intensive Course at Anglo-Continental and the 5 week Pre-Sessional Course at the University College.

The 8 week General Intensive Course is studied at our partner language school Anglo-Continental School of English. You will not have to take an IELTS test at the end of the General Intensive Course, but you are required to complete the language course successfully with good attendance, show progression of your English level, complete all homework and pass the on-going assessments.

The following charts show the IELTS scores for the 8 week General Intensive Course and the 5 week Pre-Sessional Course.

IELTS 5.5 (Overall Score)

If one or more component is below 5.0

Attendance and successful completion of the 8 week General Intensive Course at Anglo-Continental & the 5 week Pre-Sessional Course at the University College.

OR

Achieve IELTS 6.0 overall with a minimum of 5.5 in each of the 4 components.

IELTS 5.0 (Overall Score)

If all components are 4.5 or above.

Attendance and successful completion of the 8 week General Intensive Course at Anglo-Continental & the 5 week Pre-Sessional Course at the University College.

OR

Achieve IELTS 6.0 overall with a minimum of 5.5 in each of the 4 components.

General Intensive Course

The General Intensive Course is designed to improve your level of English in the four main areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking, allowing you to progress to the level required for your creative course.

The 8 week General Intensive Course consists of the following:

20 lessons of structured English language tuition and practice **plus**

5 lessons of language extension activities **plus**

5 lessons of supplementary skills, including areas such as:

- Reading and writing
- English for work and study (intermediate to advanced level)
- British life and culture.

(30 lessons per week in total, one lesson = 45 minutes)

Progression

Once you have successfully completed the 8 week General Intensive Course with good attendance, shown progression of your English level and passed the on-going assessments, you will progress onto the 5 week Pre-Sessional course at the Arts University College at Bournemouth. The 5 week course will be held on the University College campus, the course will cost £1,750 further details of the course will be given to you when you are at Anglo-Continental.

Visa Requirements

You will have a conditional offer and you will need to apply for a Tier 4 (General) student visa with a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) which has been issued by Anglo-Continental for your General Intensive Course.

After successful completion of the 8 week General Intensive course, you will be granted an unconditional offer. You should apply within the UK for a Tier 4 (General) Student visa to cover the University College 5 week Pre-Sessional course and your full-time degree course. The University College will issue the CAS for this visa application; you can start your course at the University College whilst you are waiting for your second visa to be approved. Approval is dependent on meeting all of UKBA's criteria.
