Undergraduate (Degree) Students

(All BA (Hons) courses – for first year entry)



The 13 (8 + 5) week English Pre-Sessional course is for students who have not met our minimum English language entry requirements, or are looking to improve their English language skills. Our minimum entry requirement for our degree courses is an overall IELTS score of 6.0 with a minimum score of 5.5 in each of the 4 components (Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking). The course consists of an 8 week General Intensive course at Anglo-Continental and, on successful completion, you will progress to the 5 week Pre-Sessional English course at the Arts University Bournemouth. If you decide you do not want to attend the 13 week course,

you will need to meet our minimum entry English language requirements.

If you are intending to increase your language level in your own country, please allow sufficient time and contact us as soon as you have any results. Each year several students take their time and miss the start of our Pre-Sessional course and also do not meet the language requirement and are then unable to study with us.

Please note the University also accepts a range of English language tests including TOEFL and Pearson.

8 week General Intensive course

The 8 week General Intensive Course is studied at our partner language school, Anglo-Continental School of English. You will not have to take an IELTS test at the end of the General Intensive Course, but you are required to complete the language course successfully with good attendance, show progression of your English level, show participation in class, complete all homework and pass the on-going assessments.

This course is designed to improve your level of English in the four main areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking, allowing you to progress to the level required for your creative course.

The course consists of:

- 20 lessons of structured English language tuition and practice plus
- 5 lessons of language extension activities plus
- 5 lessons of supplementary skills, including areas such as:
 - Reading and writing
 - English for work and study (intermediate to advanced level)
 - British life and culture

(30 lessons per week in total, one lesson = 45 minutes)

Progression

Once you have successfully completed the 8 week General Intensive Course with good attendance, shown progression of your English level, participation in class and passed the on-going assessments, you will progress onto the 5 week Pre-Sessional course at the Arts University Bournemouth. The 5 week course will be held on the University campus and details of the course will be given to you when you are at Anglo-Continental.

The cost of the 5 week course is £1,950

Visa Requirements

You will need to apply for a Tier 4 (General) Student visa with a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) from the Arts University Bournemouth. This will then allow you to apply for your Tier 4 (General) Student visa in your own country. The visa will cover the 13 week Pre-Sessional course, Orientation plus your degree course. Your offer for your main course will remain conditional on you successfully passing the 13 week Pre-Sessional English course; if you do not successfully complete the 13 week course your visa for the main course (degree) will be withdrawn.

University visits to Anglo-Continental School of English



All students enrolled on the General Intensive course at Anglo-Continental are classed as Arts University students. The students are therefore part of the University community from the first day of enrolment on their General Intensive course and will have full access to the University campus facilities.

Our International Student Adviser will be making frequent visits to Anglo-Continental School of English, and will arrange to see all students as a group during these visits to discuss any matters the students may have.

Accommodation
