Who can take part in a Saturday Art School course?

Our 8-week courses are open to all creative enthusiasts aged 8 - 16 years plus. We attract students with a variety of interests and experience. Our courses benefit from including a wide diversity of people who can learn and collaborate.

How do I book a Saturday Art School course?

All Saturday Art School courses can be booked easily through our online store with a debit or credit card.

Are there any specific entry requirements for Saturday Art School courses?

There are no formal entry requirements to our Saturday Art School courses as we want students to share and learn no matter what their background or previous experience.

The courses are highly practical and designed for those with a keen interest in creativity; we simply expect students to be enthusiastic and willing to learn as individuals and as part of a team.

Students do not require any previous experience to join our courses.

Each course description includes appropriate age categories for enrolment.

How many people will be on my course?

Class numbers will vary depending on the course subject; however, Saturday Art School courses typically have 16 students per course.

Can I pay in instalments?

Unfortunately, we are unable to take payments in instalments. Full payment is required when making the booking.

How do I book and pay for a course by company invoice?

What else will I need to pay for?

All materials and consumables are provided to students attending Saturday Art School courses, no further expenses or outlays are necessary.

What do I get at the end of the course?

Students who have attended 100% of their course you will be issued with an AUB Certificate of Attendance upon successful completion.

Do I get an AUB student number or email?

No, to obtain an AUB student card or email address you must be registered as an academic student at Arts University Bournemouth.

Is there free parking on-site?

Yes, parking for Saturday Art School courses is free on Campus.

What financial help or support is available to pay for course fees?

As part of our commitment to equal access in creative education and careers, we provide a limited number of funded places on our Saturday Art School. To be eligible for consideration, your child must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- The young person is currently eligible for Free School Meals.
- Your current home postcode shows that you live in an area with low levels of progression to Higher Education. Check your [eligibility for the POLAR4 measure](#) – postcodes in the lowest 2 POLAR4 quintiles qualify.
- Your current home postcode shows that you live in area that falls within the lowest 20 per cent of the Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD). Check you [eligibility for the IMD measure](#) – postcodes in the lowest 2 deciles qualify.
- The young person has been in local authority care or looked after for three months or more.
- The young person has caring responsibility for an immediate family member.
- The young person has a disability.
- A parent or carer of the young person is a serving member of the armed forces.
