3-Week portfolio preparation courses

Arts (Art and Design)

Three weeks | 25 July – 12 August 2022

This course is perfect for students aged 15+ with a passion for creative arts.

On this course you'll have the opportunity to develop your artistic expression, experiment with different mediums, and gain confidence to produce a varied portfolio of work to use towards further study, university applications or to help inform your artistic direction.

Course highlights include:

- Practical workshops and themed projects
- Sketchbooks: creative ideas development
- Typography and design, experiments in composition and collage
- Drawing and illustration
- Graphic design
- Fashion and textiles — photography and film
- Architecture and 3D design
- Mixed media and print making
- Layout and portfolio showcase
- Portfolio reviews

Through a range of practical projects in different arts subjects, you'll be encouraged to develop your ideas and enhance your creative skillset whilst building a body of work for your portfolio. You'll be guided through a variety of creative approaches and processes including practical exercises in the areas of art, design, illustration, photography, and fashion. You'll work on a series of themed projects, exploring your own creative identity whilst also developing your understanding of key creative processes.

Filmmaking

Three weeks | 25 July – 12 August 2022

The UK film industry continues to be one of the world's greatest providers of cinematic entertainment, and asks for passion, creativity, technical ability, vision, research, and commitment.

This three-week course is perfect for students aged 15+ with a passion for filmmaking and/or an interest in pursuing film or media-related studies.

Course highlights include:

- Create a short film from initial idea through to post-production
- Learn the fundamentals of filmmaking
- Storyboard development; narrative techniques
- Script writing and developing drafts
- Production design, casting, and rehearsals
- The art of directing; working with actors
- Lighting a scene, camera angles, and shot selection
- 2-3 days live film shooting
- Editing and post-production techniques, including sound editing

On this course you'll have the opportunity to explore a variety of roles within the filmmaking process – from scriptwriting to the finished film – and will develop an understanding of both the creative and technical aspects of making a film.

Working in small groups you'll develop a screenplay, including shooting script and storyboard for a short fiction film. You'll then also take part in pre-production tasks such as casting and developing a narrative, before beginning the live film shoot and post-production sessions.

Plus, you'll have the chance to work with live actors on set and learn the art of directing. Finished films will be screened at the end of the course and you'll be able to add it to your showreel.

Animation Production

Three weeks | 25 July – 12 August 2022

This three-week course is perfect for students aged 15+ who are looking for an unparalleled insight into the world of animation and production design.

You'll develop your observational and design skills through exercises in sketch, cinematic storytelling, storyboarding, scriptwriting and idea pitching, as well as through the exploration of hand-drawn techniques, and cut out and stop motion. This all leads to the production of your very own animated short film.

Course highlights include:

- 12 principles of animation
- Narrative and storyboarding
- Drawing techniques and development
- Scriptwriting and storyboarding
- Cut out techniques
- Stop motion puppets
- Pixilation
- Traditional 2D animation
- Layout and background

You'll be encouraged to use digital techniques in your work, along with drawing and illustrative methods to develop your ideas on building concepts, spatial awareness, and form.

- Project: Ancient vs Modern

Fashion Design, Styling and Textiles

Two weeks | 11 - 22 July 2022

This exciting hands-on two-week course is perfect for students aged 15+ years old that are considering either further studies or a career in fashion or textiles.

Course highlights include:

- Explore key concepts in fashion design and promotion
- Develop your fashion portfolio
- Research workshops: 3D, colour, textiles and fabric awareness
- Fashion illustration: drawing the fashion figure
- Experiment with 3D laser cutting
- Explore surface embellishment and screen printing
- Practical workshops: draping, sketching, deconstruction, machine sewing
- Create your own fashion piece
- Professional photoshoot of your designed garment

You'll be introduced to key concepts in fashion design and branding and encouraged to develop your own visual identity. From sketchbook and fashion research through to understanding colour palettes, recording fashion shapes, and understanding fabric manipulation, a series of practical workshops and inspirational study sessions will enhance your knowledge and critical awareness.

You'll be guided and shown how to translate your ideas using a variety of materials and professional equipment, culminating with the styling of a photo shoot with a makeup artist on hand.

Creative Make-up

Two weeks | 11 - 22 July 2022

This exciting hands-on two-week course is perfect for students aged 15+ years old that are passionate about make-up styles and special effects for film, television, and theatre.

You'll be guided by our expert tutors through a mix of practical workshops, demonstrations, and research where you'll explore make-up and hair design for historical and contemporary drama. Plus, you'll experiment with special effects and prosthetic make-up for film and television and learn about make-up.

Course highlights include:

- Learn key techniques and processes of creative make-up
- Avant Garde experimentation and high fashion techniques
- Casualty simulation make-up
- Developing a character
- Zombie workshop: latex and special effects
- 1920s, 1940s and 1960s make-up styles
- Use industry standard equipment in professional make-up studios
- Series of photoshoots to record your created styles to add to portfolio

As you build your design and technical skills, you'll also learn to plan and create finished looks for fashion styling and photography shoots. You'll learn and practice a range of core technical and creative techniques to increase your confidence and will be encouraged to experiment.

Extended practical sessions will give you the opportunity to create your own looks and develop your own style.

You'll work with specialist professional materials and a 'zombie workshop' will guide you through the design process and application of creating your own sci-fi transformation. Plus, you'll enhance your knowledge of iconic looks through the ages, recreating key aspects of the era.

Drawing and Illustration

Two weeks | 11 - 22 July 2022

Whether you're a budding illustrator, or simply wish to improve your drawing skills to support other creative work, this exciting two-week course is the perfect chance for students aged 15+ to get stuck in to produce thrilling and original work, as well as develop drawing techniques.

Including life drawing classes and sessions on location for inspiration, you'll cover the fundamentals of drawing and illustration. You'll also experiment with a range of materials including charcoal, inks, sticks, pastels, and acrylics to name a few.

Course highlights include:

- Drawing techniques and processes – tone, light, colour, line, shape, form, mark making, and negative space
- Life drawing and still life workshops
- Use of line, measurement, scale, and proportion
- Developing your own visual language
- Mixed media and collage experimentation
- Narrative and editorial illustration
- Basic Adobe Photoshop composition
- Presentation skills

You'll have the chance to participate in a broad range of drawing workshops led by a diverse range of inspiring, expert tutors. You'll be pushed to experiment, to learn from your mistakes and to develop critical understanding of your work.

Graphic Design and Visual Communication

Two weeks | 11 - 22 July 2022

This course is ideal for anyone looking to develop their skills in typography, poster, editorial and digital design or simply to study the effective use of visual design within communication.

Through a combination of theory, workshops, and practical projects, you'll be introduced to the fundamentals of design. With an emphasis on ideas-based problem solving, you'll develop your critical awareness of visual communication and tackle typographic and design projects.

Course highlights include:

- Enhance your knowledge of all graphic design practices
- Develop your understanding of different influences and styles and media
- Explore the importance of graphic design in branding, marketing, advertising, and packaging
- Plan, layout and realise any kind of publicity
- Professional use of Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop, and InDesign
- Enhance your ability to visually communicate your ideas and develop your visual voice
- Expert support to boost your confidence through feedback in discussions with your tutor and class
- Develop essential skills to move into the professional arena or further creative study

Through a combination of theory, workshops, and practical projects, you'll be introduced to the fundamentals of design including line, tone, colour theory, layout design, composition, type, and image across digital and paper-based formats.

You'll also explore a variety of techniques to enhance your understanding of the design process and effectively communicate ideas in 2D and 3D forms, a produce a comprehensive portfolio using graphic design, visual communication, and photography skills.

Studio Fashion Photography

Two weeks | 11 - 22 July 2022

This exciting two-week course is the perfect chance for students aged 15+ to make a huge leap forward in developing fashion photography skills, by learning the basics and so much more.

This course will develop your understanding of the creative processes necessary to create stunning fashion studio shots, furthering your knowledge in composition, framing, subject and lighting.

Course highlights include:

- Understand what makes a successful photography studio
- Studio photography for a variety of genres: advertising, portraiture, and fashion
- Set design, backgrounds, and props
- Camera controls, advanced features, and ancillary equipment
- Controlling lighting and colour using studio flash, portable flash, flags, diffusers, reflectors, etc
- Composition and framing the subject
- The lens, focus, depth of field and field of view
- Metering and histograms
- Colour temperature and white balance

Led by our expert tutors you'll explore camera functions, equipment, colour, workflow management, and specialist studio lighting. You'll develop a deeper understanding of your camera and how to take amazing pictures with it.

You'll have the opportunity to undertake a series of workshops and live shoots in areas including lighting for portraiture and fashion – employing highly stylised and cutting-edge approaches whilst developing your own creativity and ideas.

Modelmaking

Two weeks | 11 - 22 July 2022

This exciting hands-on 2-week course is perfect for students aged 15+ years old that are looking to make a big leap into making.

Modelmaking is perfect if you're interested in making or design and have an imaginative and experimental mind – from the precision of Formula One, to the Fantasy of Star Wars, it all starts here.

Course highlights include:

- Safe use of materials and tools
- Introduction to fundamental and advanced materials
- Moulding and casting techniques
- Sculpting workshop
- Construction techniques for architecture, design, and media
- Laser cutting & 3D printing techniques
- Introduction to specialist digital modelling
- Finishing and painting techniques
- Fabrication and pattern making for media

If you've a passion for creating fantasy worlds in film, television, and theatre, or designing and making props and fantastical beings then this is the course for you. Likewise, if you enjoy communicating the designs of products, structures, vehicles or buildings, informing through museums, exhibitions, and advertising, or are interested in medical prosthetics and forensic reconstructions, then this course is also for you.

As a modelmaker, you'll be in high demand across the creative industries - the possibilities are endless, and the skills you'll learn on this fast-paced course will be transferrable to many different career or study paths. Through a series of practical workshops and tutor-led sessions you'll be introduced to the processes, techniques, and finishing skills used by the professional creative industries to make models, props, and prototypes.

Make-up and Modelmaking Design Studios

TheGallery

Course entry requirements

Qualifications

There are no formal entry requirements or qualifications needed to study AUB's Summer Courses – the only thing we ask is that you share AUB's passion for the creative arts!

We want you to share and learn no matter what your background or previous experience is. All our courses are highly practical and written for those with a keen interest in creativity; we simply expect summer students to be enthusiastic and willing to learn as individuals and as part of a team.

Age

If you're planning to join our 2-week Creative Arts Summer School you must be aged 13-15 years at the time your course commences.

If you wish to join any other Summer Course – either a 3-week Portfolio Preparation or 2-week Specialist Course – you must be 15 years or over at the time the course commences, and there is no upper age limit.

English language

All AUB's Summer Courses are taught in English. There are no formal English entry requirements, however we recommend you have an intermediate level of English to benefit fully from your experience on our Summer Courses and be able to communicate with your tutors and fellow students.

What to expect on your Summer course

Throughout the summer we welcome students from all over the world; our campus is a collaborative international hub of creative activity.

Your first day

On your first day, you'll meet your course tutor or representatives from the specialist area you're studying, who'll introduce you to their creative expertise and learning environment.

You'll also start your Summer Course with a campus tour and AUB orientation event on your first course day so that you can get to know your fellow course students, the university and the Summer Course staff.

Your tutor will give you a copy of the course timetable and explain some of the workshops and sessions you'll be participating in, as well as any trips or off-campus learning that may be part of the course.

How you'll be taught

Studying on campus you'll take part in a variety of practical workshops, projects, and exercises with access to AUB specialist studios and world-class facilities.

During class you'll have the opportunity to share your thoughts and ideas and take part in group critique sessions in a relaxed and welcoming learning environment that fosters inclusivity and positive wellbeing.

The typical class size of an AUB Summer Course is between 15-20 students. You'll have dedicated support from a tutor and teaching assistants, in a fixed base room with plenty of space for storing your creative work.

Course hours

Monday – Friday, 09.30 –16.30

There'll be a daily lunch break plus other breaks within the schedule.

Your first day will start at 09.30 and the Summer Courses team will contact you before you arrive with your full joining instructions, so you know where to go.

Your last day

The last day of your course will finish at 16.30.

After lunch there'll be presentations and farewells, giving you the opportunity to exhibit your work plus see the work of the other Summer Course students too.

Family and friends are welcome to visit AUB for the post-course exhibitions – just invite them to come along!

Whilst studying your Summer Course you're guaranteed to receive a pre-application interview and portfolio review for the course(s) of your choice.

If you're made an offer to continue your studies at AUB we'll handle your application, so you don't have to, therefore completely removing the stress of applying to university!

Residential packages

When you book your course, you have the chance to add our residential package to your booking. This is a very popular option as it gives you the chance to experience life as a full-time university student and part of the #AUBMAKERS community.

Due to popularity, summer accommodation in AUB's new Halls of Residence is allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. We highly recommend you book your accommodation as soon as possible to guarantee it – simply select the residential option when you book your course place.

Please note, the residential package varies depending on your course. You can identify which package you're eligible for based on the age range specified for your course. This is noted on the course information page.

The Creative Arts Summer School course is designed especially for students aged 13-15. The residential package includes:

- Full board: all evening and weekend meals provided on campus
- Single study bedroom with private en-suite bathroom
- Halls of Residence Wi-Fi
- Access to shared kitchens and cooking facilities
- Laundry facilities, student social common room
- 24-hour on-site security staff and live-in AUB residential staff – help is available 24/7
- An extended programme of evening social activities, including regular evening BBQ's
- Weekend sightseeing and shopping excursions
- Airport taxi transfers

Residential package for students aged 15+

You're eligible for this residential package if you're choosing to study any AUB Summer Course except the Creative Arts Summer School. The residential package for students aged 15+ includes:

- Half board: breakfast and lunch provided on campus
- Single study bedroom with private en-suite bathroom
- Halls of Residence Wi-Fi
- Access to shared kitchens and cooking facilities
- Laundry facilities, student social common room
- 24-hour on-site security staff and live-in AUB residential staff – help is available 24/7
- Full programme of evening social activities, including regular evening BBQ's
- Weekend sightseeing and shopping excursions
- Optional airport taxi transfer – select this option when you book your course place

Your accommodation in AUB's Halls of Residence

Our accommodation is situated on-campus, it's a 20-minute bus ride to Bournemouth's town centre and award-winning beaches, with shops and cafes also nearby, which you can explore in your free time.

Within the accommodation there's Wi-Fi internet access, laundry facilities, and a large social room. You'll also have:

- 24-hour security and live-in accommodation support team – help is available 24/7
- En-suite private room in a cluster flat with shared kitchen and lounge
- Rooms are furnished with single bed, wardrobe, drawers, desk, and chair
- All bed linen supplied
- Weekly cleaning

University accommodation is available on the Sunday before your course commences and you can stay in your accommodation the Friday night after your course finishes.

All bedrooms must be vacated by 10am on the Saturday immediately following the completion of your course. You can leave luggage in our reception if necessary.

Expenses and money

For those staying in our accommodation, breakfast and lunch will be provided in our campus refectory with a selection of hot and cold choices in a variety of cuisines.

If you have a half-board residential package (all courses except the Creative Arts Summer School) you'll need to purchase and cater for your evening meals.

There are several large food supermarkets nearby; you can cook and prepare your meals in the accommodation kitchens.

Student ambassadors will also be on hand to advise and direct you to local cafes and restaurants, should you wish to eat out during your time in Bournemouth.

If you live locally or have chosen to book just the Summer Course and arrange your accommodation independently, you should allow sufficient funds for additional meals, activities or any personal purchases required.



Social activity programme

There'll be evening activities and weekend day trips included within the residential package at no extra cost that you can choose to take part in, with free time also in your schedule so you can enjoy Bournemouth and explore the local area.

There'll also be some additional optional evening activities that may require an additional supplement charge. More details about our social activities will be available closer to the start of your course.

Activities will include:

- City day trips
- Beach sports and games
- Movie nights
- Quizzes/board games
- Local shopping
- AUB BBQs
- Dance classes
- Skills sharing event with AUB students
- Tenpin bowling and golf



Bournemouth

Be inspired by your surroundings and discover what's beyond the campus during the summer. We're situated in a safe coastal location with award-winning beaches, a lively social scene and lots of cultural attractions and events throughout the year. Our small size means we're a tight-knit community that's friendly as well as accessible.

Bournemouth is one of the top destinations for tourists and as a town with three universities and large number of language schools, it attracts a diverse mixture of international students.

The best of England is on our doorstep too – we're just a two-hour train ride from London with other popular location such as Dorset's Jurassic Coast (World Heritage Site) and the New Forest National Park nearby.

Travelling to Bournemouth

Every year we have students who travel from as little as 2 miles away, to those who travel across the world over 7,000 miles away from home. Wherever you're travelling from we can arrange to meet you and ensure you arrive safely at AUB.

Airport taxi transfers

When you book your Summer Course, you'll have the option to book a private airport taxi transfer for an additional fee.

If you choose to book AUB's private airport taxi transfer, a taxi will collect you from Arrivals at Heathrow or Gatwick airport and bring you directly to our Halls of Residence – this is approximately a 2-3 hour journey.

Once you have booked and paid for your taxi transfer and have your flight details arranged, the AUB Summer Courses staff will be in touch to allocate a taxi transfer with you and let you know the details of your driver and collection point.

Arrival for 3-week courses

If you're taking part in one of our 3-week courses, you must ensure that your flight arrives in the UK no later than Sunday 24 July as your course will commence on Monday 25 July 2022.


Arrival for 2-week courses

If you're taking part in one of our 2-week courses, you must ensure that your flight arrives in the UK no later than Sunday 10 July as your course will commence on Monday 11 July 2022.

Arrival at AUB accommodation

When you arrive at AUB's accommodation (if you've booked the optional residential package with your course) friendly Student Ambassadors will be in the main reception to welcome you from 09.00 to 22.00. They'll show you to your room, explain how everything works and share arrangements for your first day.

If you're arriving outside of these times you should report to the accommodation main reception (manned 24/7) where security staff will show you to your allocated room.





Welfare, supervision and safety

We take security and the wellbeing of our students very seriously and are proud to say that Bournemouth is one of the safest parts of the UK.

We've measures in place to ensure you'll be safe and always looked after:

- Orientation and induction sessions to help you enjoy the campus and your accommodation safely
- Trained first aiders
- Security staff on campus and in AUB Halls of Residence – available 24/7
- On-site residential support staff – available 24/7
- Sign out procedure for free time and nightly curfews

We ask all parent(s)/guardian(s) of students aged under 18 to read and agree to our supervision arrangements.

Course supervision

The safety and wellbeing of our students is always our top priority, with a high staff to student ratio on our courses.

During your time at AUB, you'll be fully supported by a team of trained and experienced staff who will monitor your wellbeing and ensure any concerns you may have are heard and resolved swiftly where possible.

All course tutors and teaching staff are DBS checked, plus we have on-campus security and appointed First Aiders. What's more, a complete risk assessment is undertaken for all activities, including off-campus trips.

AUB Accommodation

If you book our optional residential package, you'll have access to our experienced pastoral support team, including live-in residential staff to oversee your safety and wellbeing 24/7. A short walk from your accommodation you'll find the local doctor's surgery and you can also arrange to have a chat with one of AUB's expert counsellors if you require any additional support.

Students under 18 are situated in a separate accommodation block within the same complex and have extra residential support during evenings and weekends. Accommodation support staff are on hand to keep an eye on your wellbeing and ensure any concerns you may have are heard and resolved swiftly, where possible.

Course fees

The great news is that all teaching, materials, resources, and equipment is included in your course fee, as well as any travel and admission costs for study trips. Your course fee also includes a print credit so you can print your work on campus for free. Plus, you'll have free access to Wi-Fi and unrestricted access to all campus resources including our extensive arts library.

The fee for your course will vary depending on type and its duration:

- Creative Arts Summer School (13-15): £1,995
- 2-week Specialist Art, Design, and Media Course (15+): £1,395
- 3-week Portfolio Preparation Course (15+): £1,995

This fee does not include any optional extras such as residential package and airport taxi transfer.



How to book

To book your place just head to our **website** where you'll be able to secure your place by clicking the 'book now' button on your chosen course's webpage.

You'll book your course through AUB's secure online store – you'll be required to create an account as part of the booking process.

Optional extras

During the booking process you'll have the option to customise your booking with our optional extras for an additional fee:

- Residential package
- Airport taxi transfer

If you wish to take advantage of these extras simply select the option when prompted during the booking process. The fee for these extras will be added to your course fee during the booking process.

Paying for your course

You can secure your place with an initial deposit payment of just £795. The remaining balance will be due by 27 May 2022.

If you book your place on or after 27 May 2022 please note that the full balance of your fees will be required upfront.

On the booking page you'll be prompted to pay online by debit or credit card. Once payment has been received, we'll send you an email confirming your payment and your place on the course.

The email will also include further instructions on how to pay the remaining balance of your course fees.

You'll also receive details of any further steps needed to complete your booking, such as providing AUB with a copy of your passport, visa (where applicable) and any consent or supervision forms for students aged under 18.

Alternative payment methods

If you're making a payment from an overseas account, you'll need to add an additional £30 for the bank charges.

If you're applying for a visa and need documents to support your visa, please note that payment confirmation letters for visa applications will only be issued once the course fees and any accommodation you have booked have been paid in full.

Please ensure you email us at **summercourses@aub.ac.uk** to let us know if you wish to pay via Bank Transfer so we can issue your invoice.

Disability disclosure

We welcome applications from students with disabilities. However, it's essential that you contact us at the time you make your booking to discuss any support needs. This way we can help you from the very beginning of the course.

By disclosing your disability to us you gain access to the professional, confidential services that the Disability and Learning Support Team can provide.

The term 'disability' refers to mobility difficulties, mental health difficulties, autism/Asperger's syndrome, chronic fatigue syndrome/ME, visual/hearing impairment, learning difficulties such as dyslexia and dyspraxia, as well as medical conditions such as epilepsy or asthma.

It's important that if you have a disability that requires assistance in any way, you should complete a Disability Disclosure form and return it to the Summer Course Office promptly. The information you provide will be treated confidentially and will only be shared with others with your permission.

Accessibility

Whilst the campus is wheelchair accessible, with automatic doors, lifts, and toilets all suitable for wheelchair users, access to certain studios and departments may be limited. In instances where access is limited, we'll endeavour to ensure that classes and tutorials are undertaken within accessible spaces.

Parking is available on campus for students with mobility difficulties. If you hold a disabled parking badge or have a medical condition, you'll be able to access the car park at all times.

If you have asthma or breathing difficulties, the atmosphere within some workshop areas may aggravate your condition and you should discuss with your doctor any health implications prior to your being exposed to these hazards.

The campus is fitted with a deaf alerted fire alarm system, which provides free of charge vibrating pagers to students with hearing impairments to use.

Booking terms and conditions

Payment

All payments are made using our secure online booking system, the AUB Store.

A deposit option is available to secure your place with an initial deposit of £795 of your full course fee (including any optional extras, such as airport taxi and residential packages).

Please note any booking made on, or after, 27 May 2022 full course fees shall be required to secure your course place.

Company payment

If a company or place of work is paying for your course fees, please proceed with the booking process online in the usual manner until you reach the payment stage – then stop.

Please contact us when you have done this via summercourses@aub.ac.uk adding the company address to send the invoice to.

Once our Finance department have received and cleared payment your place will be secured. We'll then email you a confirmation letter.

Confirmation of your place on the course

Once we've received and processed your booking, you'll receive a payment confirmation via an automated email and an additional confirmation letter will be emailed to you.

Cancellation by us

In the unlikely event that we have to cancel a course we'll inform you as soon as possible before the start date, and we'll refund any payments we have received in full, or you can select an alternative course.

It is compulsory for you to be at all times comprehensively insured to cover all costs and consequences of recovery of course fees and flights booked or needed in the event of cancellation or early departure. We'll not be liable for any losses (including, but not limited to, travel and accommodation costs) arising because of any modification or cancellation of courses or timetabling constraints beyond the cost of the course fee.

AUB reserves the right to make changes to the course programme as may be necessary for reasons of quality, operational efficiency, or circumstances,

including industrial action and weather conditions beyond our control. If we cancel a course, all participants will be notified, and payments refunded in full. Refunds of fees will normally only be made in the event of the cancellation of a class by AUB.

If AUB decides to cancel the course because of Covid or another national lockdown, we'll refund all fees paid in full.

Cancellations by you

All cancellations must be made in writing to summercourses@aub.ac.uk.

If you wish to cancel your summer course place, you'll be entitled to a full refund only if your cancellation is received within two weeks of paying for your course in full, or your deposit. If we receive your cancellation no later than 60 days prior to the start date of your summer course, you'll be entitled to a refund of the course fees paid, minus an administration fee of £250.

If you need to cancel your course place and have paid the deposit only, you'll be entitled to a refund minus an administration fee of £250.

Where a cancellation is made less than 60 days prior to the start date of your course, you'll not be entitled to a refund.

If you're unable to attend a class(s) during the course, due to illness or for personal or professional reasons, you'll not be eligible for a refund, extra tuition, or a course transfer.

In case you won't be able to travel to UK in 2022 due to travel restrictions because of Covid, we'll refund all fees paid.

Changing course

If you're considering changing courses, please email summercourses@aub.ac.uk at least 6 weeks in advance of the course start date, to see if there are places available so we can transfer you onto another course. Regrettably where there are no places available, we'll not be able to change your course or offer you a refund.

Non-attendance

Non-attendance of classes due to illness or for personal or professional reasons does not provide the right to a refund, extra tuition, or a transfer.

You'll need to have a 100% attendance record to qualify for a course certificate.

Age restrictions

The Creative Arts Summer School is available to 13-15 year old students.

All other Summer Courses are available to anyone over the age of 15, with no upper age limit.

Students residing in AUB accommodation

As you'll be sharing accommodation it is important you take responsibility by being a good neighbour and show consideration for others, including ensuring you're not responsible for any noise, which is audible outside of your room between the hours of 22.30 and 08.00.

You'll be living in a non-smoking environment and are not permitted to smoke inside the accommodation or in the gardens.

Any breach of the accommodation regulations, which will be explained on arrival, may result in a student being asked to leave.

You're responsible for keeping your own room tidy as well as the communal kitchen and charges may be implemented where there is evidence of deliberate damage. Any student raising a false fire alarm will be asked to leave.

You should report any faults or items in need of repair promptly.

If you're aged under 18 you'll be allocated a student ambassador, who will need to know where you're at all times. There'll be supervised kitchen times available every evening and weekend. If you wish to cook food using the kitchens, you should bring sufficient funds to purchase your food. If you wish to use the kitchen at other times you must make sure there is a student ambassador present.

There'll also be supervised activities available in the accommodation and within the local area. You'll need to sign in and out of your accommodation and provide contact details if you choose to eat your meals or take part in activities independently. A curfew time of 22.30 will be strictly upheld for all students. If you're found to be abusing any of the trust offered by the Student Ambassador, you may be asked to move to a home stay environment.

All students under the age of 16 years old are not permitted to leave the Campus Halls of Residence unless supervised by a Student Ambassador or unless their parents have given written permission via the Independent Travel form. This must be returned to **summercourses@aub.ac.uk**.

Students not residing in AUB accommodation

You're not obliged to book our Residential Programme and can find your own accommodation.

AUB is not responsible for finding any alternative accommodation if you don't book our residential package.

You're responsible for your own transport to and from campus.

You're not automatically entitled to join in any evening and weekend activities arranged by AUB. This can only be arranged in the discretion of the Summer Courses team. Contact **summercourses@aub.ac.uk** to discuss.

Travelling to and from your accommodation

Unless transport from airports to halls is explicitly offered as part of your course or you have booked an airport taxi transfer with AUB, you and your parent(s)/guardian(s) must make sure that you're sufficiently independent and capable of travelling to AUB alone, or your parent(s)/guardian(s) must arrange an escort for you.

In case travel arrangements go badly wrong, parent(s)/guardian(s) should make sure that you have enough money (GBP pounds sterling) to be able to take taxi to their accommodation direct from your point of entry into the UK or other location within the UK.

You need to speak enough English to be able to ask for and understand directions, use public transport, and buy any refreshments you need on the way to your accommodation.

We encourage you to contact your parent(s)/guardian(s) to confirm safe arrival, and we don't routinely confirm safe arrivals. If a parent(s)/guardian(s) does not know whether you have arrived safely, the parent(s)/guardian(s) should contact you in the first instance. If the parent/guardian is not able to contact you, the parent(s)/guardian(s) should contact either the Halls of Residence **+44 1202 533011** or the Summer Courses office at **+44 1202 363222**.

You and your parent(s)/guardian(s) are also responsible for arranging your arrival and return journeys. If airport transfers are not in your fees or you have not booked an AUB airport taxi transfer, you and your parent(s)/guardian(s) must make sure that you're sufficiently independent and capable of travelling back to your home on your own, or your parent(s)/guardian(s) must arrange an escort for you.

AUB can arrange a private taxi airport transfer from London or Gatwick airports only, and this is payable in advance from the website or by request at summercourses@aub.ac.uk. The deadline for this is June 24 2022. After this date we cannot guarantee availability.

AUB student enrolment policy for Summer Course students

You'll provide information as part of the application process which is held by the University. Your enrolment is confirmed when you pay the fee and is ratified on the first day of attendance. By paying the fee and attending a class, you're agreeing to the terms and conditions of enrolment. Read our university regulations for more details about our Student Enrolment Policy and the Terms and Conditions of Enrolment at AUB.

Behaviour

You'll be encouraged to be professional at all times and although the environment is relaxed and friendly, we expect everyone to be respectful and not intimidating or racist to other students or AUB staff members. Anyone who does not respect this code of conduct will be withdrawn from the course with immediate effect. In these instances, you'll not be entitled to any refund.

Use of imagery

There may be occasions during the course for you to participate in promotional activities undertaken by Arts University Bournemouth, including photography and video recording. These activities may result in the production of materials featuring students in AUB brochures, posters, websites, newsletters, and marketing campaigns. We need your permission for this. Please complete and return the 'Permission to Use Imagery' form that we'll send you via email.

Data protection

The information provided by you when booking your course and creating an account with AUB will be used by the Summer Course team to provide the delegate with the information needed to attend their course and to provide services in relation to said course. We may also contact you to request feedback to improve the services we offer. We'll share your response and feedback anonymously with your tutors to allow them to run the course effectively.

Your information will be held securely on our management information system in line with the General Data Protection Regulations. (Our retention schedule states that we'll hold information for three years from last point of contact if no permission to market or five years if permission held, so we can be more specific re: how long we hold information for).

Occasionally we may wish to notify you by post, email or phone about events, news, and opportunities. Under the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) we're required to obtain your consent to add you to our mailing list. If you provide consent to this when booking your course, your name and address will also be held in our marketing system. We'll keep you on our mailing list until you inform us that you no longer wish to be on it. You can opt-out of our mailing list at any time by emailing summercourses@aub.ac.uk.

We'll not share your personal information with any third parties unless required by law, nor will we sell your details.

However, we may share your personal email address with your course tutor, specifically to support course delivery and effective communications between student and tutor.

There may be occasions during the course for students to participate in promotional activities for AUB, including photography and video recording. We'll ask your permission to use these images and recordings at the beginning of your course (refer to your Family of Forms). We may subsequently use these images and recordings in our promotions, online, in print and on social media. We'll not include your personal details in these promotions.

Your personal information is your personal property and as such we recognise that this places serious responsibilities on us. Arts University Bournemouth have therefore published a separate Privacy Policy on these web pages.
