3-WEEK UK SUMMER COURSE

An introduction into the fundamentals of interior design

Developing the ability to communicate and evaluate your creative ideas with the relationship and needs of your client are fundamental to this dynamic and exciting design discipline. In this 3-week course you will explore the ideas behind habitable space; what a habitable space is, functions, users, public and private space and regulations.

You will also consider the design and communication of that space through the understanding of scale and proportion and the use of drawing conventions such as plan, section, elevation and 3D drawings. The atmosphere of your designs will be further explored through the use of colour, texture and materials whilst research and practical work will improve your knowledge in 3D thinking and spacial analysis.

Taught by members of the university's BA (Hons) Interior Architecture & Design programme through a mixture of illustrated lectures, workshops, group discussions and research, this course will give you an excellent introduction to one of the most demanding and innovative of contemporary design professions in practice today. During the course you will also be set a project in the form of a client brief with you acting as designer to a fictitious client, giving you the opportunity to experience working on a realistic brief and the processes involved.

The course will culminate in a presentation and critique of your project designs to your tutor and your colleagues, enabling you to evaluate your design and receive feedback as if in a real design practice. All materials, equipment and resources are included within the course fee; during your course there may also be the opportunity to attend an excursion trip to a location that will further enhance your understanding of this subject.
