This course is designed for individuals with an interest in architecture and for students studying art, design, architecture, landscape and all other subjects related to the built environment. Centred on the creative processes of 'thinking and making', it provides a strong foundation in the fundamentals of architectural design.

Through a series of workshops and educational visits to sites of architectural importance you will explore British architecture styles. You will contrast the ancient with the modern to develop an appreciation of design. There will be the opportunity to sketch and develop your drawing skills to illustrate your architectural ideas regarding building concepts, spatial awareness and form.

Your knowledge and design skills will be enhanced through a series of 3D model-making workshops using manual and digital manufacturing equipment. Our specialised library will provide you with a wealth of information and resources in architecture and the arts.

The course will include a practical project whereby you will be required to research and design a new structure to work with existing buildings, considering issues such as materials, access and sustainability. You will develop your problem-solving, technical and aesthetic abilities, using a wide variety of processes to answer a challenging design brief and further inform your approach to architecture and urban planning.

No previous knowledge or experience is required to join the course, just an enthusiasm and interest in architecture and design.
