



# TAILORING

AN INTRODUCTION TO MALE AND FEMALE ENGLISH TAILORING TECHNIQUES, CUT AND CONSTRUCTION

**3 WEEKS**

8th – 26th July 2013



The first part of the course offers an introduction to the dynamic 'New Look' period of female couture fashion of the late 1940's. You will study the complexities of cut, construction and the fit of a female jacket by working on a part jacket toile and constructing this to the fitting stage, looking at cut, construction and the exploration of couture tailoring methods.

The second part of the course offers an introduction to English male tailoring methods and gives a basic understanding of the development of male tailoring from the late 18th century to the present day. You will study some of the complex techniques of bespoke tailoring through the cut and construction of a male waistcoat.

This course will be supported by a museum visit to view and study original period garments.
