TERMS AND CONDITIONS



THE WORK AND ENTRY

1. Your creation can be as large as you like, just remember to keep it landscape. Your art work will be recreated for print so unfortunately sculptures, film, 3D and audio won't work.
2. You don't have to send us your actual artwork for judging – a photo or a jpeg will be fine. The image you send us of your entry should be no larger than 1200px wide at 150dpi resolution.
3. Artwork submitted must be original and have been created by the artist(s) named in the submission.
4. Artwork can be submitted by someone other than the artist, but by submitting the entrant must confirm that they have express permission of the artist to represent them.

Entering artists are confirming that they are between the age of 16 – 18 years only. Artists found to be younger/ older than this will be disqualified. Proof of age will be required for all shortlisted entrants. You must be aged between 16 - 18 years at the time of entry.

5. Artwork will not be sold as part of this competition.
6. Artwork submitted for the competition must be exclusive and not appear on other public relations/ advertisements without permission from the AUCB and JCDecaux.
7. Submissions must be accompanied by the entrants name, address etc. Artwork that is submitted without this information will not be considered.
8. Entries must arrive by midnight on the 9th March 2012. Entries after the deadline will not be considered.
9. Successful entrants will be notified via email/ telephone if they are shortlisted by 14th March 2012.

10. Entry is taken as consent to reproduce your artwork. Artwork will only be used for purposes connected to “Who are you” competition and will be credited. Copyright of work remains with the artist and any enquiries for copyright will be addressed to the artist.

11. Entrants selected for the shortlist will be notified by 14th March 2012. Shortlisted entries will form part of the public vote on Facebook between 19th - 21st March 2012. If you are not notified by 14th March, please assume that your submission has been unsuccessful.

12. Shortlisted entrants will be required to supply a description of how their entry fulfils the brief using a maximum of 50 words. Please note that the description together with your artwork, name and school/college or location will be uploaded onto our Facebook page to form part of the public vote.

13. The shortlisted entries will be viewed by all members of the public, so please do not submit any work that may include offensive images or language. If we receive any work that is deemed unsuitable for a wider audience, the entry will be discarded.

14. The “Who Are You” competition decisions on the selection of shortlisted artwork is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

15. If the public vote results in a draw then the judges decision will be final.

THE EXHIBITION

1. Successful winning entries will form part of the exhibition taking place between 25th - 28th April 2012 at the Arts University College at Bournemouth.

2. Winners will be notified and invited to the private view and celebration event taking place on 25th April 2012 at 6pm. Coverage of the event will be documented by a photographer/film maker and be used at a later date in publicity materials.
